

# LOOKING IN FROM THE OUTSIDE

Life is bigger inside the Church than outside it, but from the outside it can look as if being Catholic is a life of narrow rules for narrow-minded people. If you ask people why they're Catholic, you'll get a lot of different answers. Sometimes those answers are inadequate—not because they're wrong, but because they fail to convey the breadth and depth of Catholicity in a way that can be appreciated or embraced by others. For example:

- "I'm Catholic because my parents raised me that way." That's not wrong: God commanded us to honor our father and mother. But if your parents didn't raise you that way, or if they only did a half-hearted job of raising you at all, does that mean you shouldn't be Catholic, or that you're not eligible? No! The commandment anticipates the kingdom of Heaven and the communion of the saints, Jesus' eternal and spiritual family. Our earthly families and other institutions are baby steps toward eternal life. So Catholic families, non-Catholic families, and the broken or incomplete families all find their fulfillment in Christ and his Church.
- "I'm Catholic because of the Real Presence." There's deep truth there, but what does that mean to outsiders or folks on the margins of Church life? Do they know what "Real Presence" means to you? Do they hear you inviting them to receive the love of Jesus, or suggesting they aren't as spiritual as you? How do you lean into the former, not the latter?

These are the kinds of problems that come up in Alpha, our beginning course for missionary discipleship. There we learn to talk about Jesus' sacraments, faith, the Bible, and the Church, and to do so in a way in which we can be heard by others. Unfortunately, in response to the dramatic rise in community spread of COVID-19, the Alpha cohort scheduled to begin on February 1 has been postponed. Parish finances, continued: I promised ongoing explanations of parish finances. One way to explain would be to publish a budget and show week-by-week or month-by-month comparisons between the budget and actual numbers. But we haven't had an effective budget for four years. First, there were the dramatic changes in staff and parish financing with the beginning of on mission, early in the 2018-19 fiscal year, from July 1 through June 30. We attempted to budget for the 2019-20 fiscal year, but then the pandemic made nonsense of our plans, and we abandoned budgeting for cash flow projections. Revenues and expenses have since become steadier, so we'll be resuming the budgeting process this spring, for the 2022-23 fiscal year—but only tentatively, because we don't have a "normal" year as our baseline. The most reliable data will for us be the most recent months, from which we will try to extrapolate for the year.


Race relations were a big concern for St. Paul and early Christians, who were torn between Jewish and Greek expressions of Christianity. In his letters, St. Paul sternly rebukes even St. Peter himself, when he gives in to the temptation to treat Christians of Jewish ethnicity differently from Christians of Greek ethnicity. Yet for many generations, Christians in the United States tolerated or even promoted racial discrimination. This week our country commemorates the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., who six decades ago so robustly called out the failures of clergy and faithful in the U.S. on relations between black and white Americans. Please say a prayer of gratitude for the Civil Rights movement of the 1950s and 60s, or a prayer for racial reconciliation.

And while you're at it, please say a prayer for the **Most Rev. Mark Eckman**, who last week was ordained a bishop and will be auxiliary to Bishop Zubik of Pittsburgh. It's not an easy time to be a Catholic, nor a priest, and least of all a bishop.

To one is given through the Spirit the expression of wisdom; to another, the expression of knowledge according to the same Spirit; to another, faith by the same Spirit; to another, gifts of healing by the one Spirit; to another, mighty deeds; to another, prophecy; to another, discernment of spirits; to another, varieties of tongues; to another, interpretation of tongues. But one and the same Spirit produces all of these, distributing them individually to each person as he wishes.

# GOSPEL — JOHN 2:1-11

There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you." Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water." So they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter." So they took it. And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine, without knowing where it came from — although the servers who had drawn the water knew — the headwaiter called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now." Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him.


