YOUTH MINISTRY OVERVIEW

What Teens Need from Youth Ministry

Teens do NOT connect to programs; they connect to people. The most effective way to influence teens is through a significant relationship with key people in their lives. Our goal is to develop adult leaders who will walk the journey to Christ with teens.

CORE Team

The CORE Team is a group of adults who make Life Teen and EDGE possible by being an active presence to our teens. CORE Team members volunteer much of their time in creating Sunday Life Nights or Wednesday EDGE Nights, being present during off-campus trips, and, most importantly, leading teens closer to our Lord by walking with them in their faith journey.

The *weekly* time commitment for Life Teen CORE is 3-6 hours.

The *monthly* time commitment for EDGE CORE is 7-10 hours.

Life/EDGE Support Team

The Life Support Team is a group of adults who support the youth ministry through a variety of duties such as preparing delicious meals, taking photos for the website, leading praise and worship, helping out in the office, or creating exciting environments for a particular Life Night or EDGE Night.

The time commitment for both the Life Support and EDGE Support Teams is 2-4 hours per month.

What Teens Need

There are many things that make a good CORE team member. Simply put, teens need adults on CORE team who will:

- Love God and live for Him.
- Be interested in their lives.
- Go to "their world."
- Pray for them.
- Be patient.
- Say encouraging words.

- Laugh with them.
- Take initiative to spend time with them.
- Remember their names.
- Be witnesses to God's love.
- Be consistently present.
- Enjoy life.

- Team members must continue to possess the above-mentioned qualities throughout the duration of their commitment. Team members are free at any time to unconditionally terminate their relationship as a Team member. Also, the Coordinator of Youth Ministry retains the option to ask you to step out if it becomes unwise for you to continue in this ministry.
