

DMI SURVEY AND NEXT GENERATION PARISH UPDATE

Again, we want to thank everyone who participated in completing the Discipleship Maker Index Survey. We had a total of 921 surveys completed.

We look forward to receiving the results of the survey and sharing the information with you late this summer or early fall. The Parish Pastoral Council is currently reviewing the Pastoral Plan that was developed in 2020-2021. When the DMI Survey results are available to us, we will work with our Christian Leadership Institute consultant on a new Pastoral Plan, which will reflect the work of the Parish Pastoral Council and incorporate the DMI Survey information.

As we envision our future together, we are participating with the team from the Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI) over the next four years to grow into a Next Generation Parish (NGP). The NGP initiative is a four-year experience aimed at transforming the future of the Church through innovative and dynamic accompaniment that helps parishes meet the challenges of our time through visionary models that foster spiritual maturity, share leadership, offer a vibrant Sunday experience, and embrace a missionary impulse.

Based on our survey results, CLI will provide our parish with a process to assess our greatest opportunities and strengths, develop a plan to move into the future, and cultivate a deeper missionary spirit within the community. This is an exciting time, growing together as disciples of Jesus!

Here is a graphic which shows the timeline for the analysis and implementation of the DMI Survey results.

PHASE 1: PREPARE

Assess the parish health, culture, and effectiveness.

Time Period: 4-5 months

PHASE 2: ENVISION

Create a parish plan with priorities and goals.

Time Period: 6-7 months

PHASE 3: IMPLEMENTATION

Empower parishes to sustain and expand their pool of leaders. This 24-month phase helps train and support clergy, staff, and parishioners in leadership and evangelization.

Time Period: 24 months

PHASE 4: ASSESS, LEARN, GROW

Measure impact, refine plans, and celebrate successes. Begin planning for the next steps, in the future.

Time Period: 6-7 months

EXPLORING OUR FAITH Sixth Sunday of Easter

The Sunday Gospel

John 14:15-21

The mystery of the Trinity can be difficult for us to grasp. Today's Gospel invites us to consider how the three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit— work together so that God's salvation is made known to us. Jesus' mission is continued through the activity of the Holy Spirit in the lives of his disciples. We have received this same Spirit through our Baptisms. The Spirit, living and working within us, reveals the mystery of God's love for us. Just as the first disciples were not left orphaned, we are not orphaned; we remain in God's embrace through the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Jesus promises his disciples that he will send them another advocate, the Spirit of truth.

Gather your family and invite each family member to say what he or she knows about the Holy Spirit. Read aloud today's Gospel, John 14:15-21. What does Jesus say the Holy Spirit will do for the disciples? Through the gift of the Holy Spirit, we come to share in the love of God made known to us in Jesus. Pray together, thanking God for this gift of the Holy Spirit by praying the Prayer to the Holy Spirit.

Our Extended Family

St. Gianna Beretta Molla Feast Day April 28 October 4, 1922 – April 28, 1962



St. Gianna was a faithful pediatrician from Italy and a member of the St. Vincent de Paul Society. She had three children at home and was pregnant again in 1961 when she developed a tumor in the same place she was carrying the baby. St. Gianna allowed the surgeons to remove the tumor but not perform the complete hysterectomy they recommended, which would have killed the child. She chose to preserve her child's life, showing she was willing to give her own life to save her baby.

Gianna gave birth to a healthy daughter, but passed away eight days later, due to complications from delivery. That child, named Gianna Emanuela, grew up to become a physician herself.

When Gianna was canonized a saint, her husband and children were there, which marked the first time a husband was present for his wife's canonization. She is the patron saint of mothers, unborn children, and physicians.

One image of the Holy Spirit is fire, so why not make a sweet dessert over a flame?

Ingredients

Marshmallows
Graham Crackers
Chocolate

Put a large marshmallow on a metal skewer and hold it over a heated flame. You can use a fire pit, a grill, or even a gas burner on your stove. Parents may need to do this step! Be sure to follow fire-safety precautions with the flame.

Once the marshmallow is cooked enough for your liking, put it between two graham crackers to make a sandwich. You can also add a piece of chocolate to the sandwich! Get as creative as you want!

Family Fun

Take your mom, grandma, or godmother on a scavenger hunt that leads to her favorite places (i.e., church, a coffee shop, a café for lunch, or a spot in the park). At each location, she gets a note, drawing, or letter from a different member of the family telling her how much they love her. The kids get involved by making something for mom and getting to surprise her with these notes. Plus, the whole family gets to go on an adventure too!




