

#### THE ESSENTIAL ROLE OF PRAYER

As we heard in the gospel for Ascension Thursday, Jesus commissioned the Apostles to baptize and evangelize. Being sent forth by Christ meant engaging the people of God with the conviction of the Holy Spirit. There are no barriers to this holy work. As we move to the first reading today, we find the Apostles choosing a necessary step before they start this missionary activity. They gather in an upper room, along with those closest to them, including Mary, and they devote themselves to constant prayer.

What does this choice of theirs say to you? If the biggest mission of all time, which continues today, begins with prayer, what are we doing before we engage in any life-giving activity of our own? The power of prayer is not isolated to the individual believer. It extends through our conscious undertakings of good will. Prayer

implores our Lord to bestow mercy, consolation, forgiveness, deliverance, revelation, and so much more upon us so that we are enabled to fulfil His mission in our lives today. The Gospel must be made known through the faithful, so the community knows its meaning through our apostolic, missionary lives.

The question has been posed of whether we should be evangelizing the new or re-evangelizing our own people. YES! DO BOTH! Whomever accepts your invitation brings to our shared table of the Lord a bounty of gifts and talents that build up the kingdom of God TODAY! Our parish needs revitalization as well. We are in dire need of parishioners to step forward to serve liturgically and to support our outreach programs and all the vital groups we foster. Please answer the call of Christ!

Pentecost is next week. With what spirit of faith in action will the people of Archangel Gabriel Parish show gratitude for all the Lord has given us from His undying love?



The Season of Easter concludes next weekend with the celebration of the Feast of Pentecost. On Pentecost we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles gathered in the upper room in Jerusalem. Jesus fulfilled his promise to send to his disciples a helper, an advocate who would enable them to be his witnesses throughout the world. This event marks the beginning of the Church.

In honor of this joyous occasion, it is popular tradition to wear red to Mass, to signify the presence of the Holy Spirit in our community and our unity in Christ. We ask that you help us fill the church with red by wearing something red to Mass next Sunday in celebration of the Holy Spirit.

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful. And kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you will renew the face of the earth.


# CORPUS CHRISTI CELEBRATION St. Malachy Church Saturday, June 10

#### **NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT**





### Our Extended Family

Sts. Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, Archangels Feast Day September 29



St. Michael, St. Gabriel, and St. Raphael are the only angels named in the Bible. Angels are represented throughout the Bible as spiritual beings who mediate between God and men. Each of them has an important role in the story of our salvation. St. Michael appears in Daniel's vision as "the great prince," who defends Israel against its enemies. In the Book of Revelation, he leads God's armies to final victory over the forces of evil. Gabriel is best known for his encounter with Mary, who consents to bear the Messiah. We encounter Raphael in the Old Testament story of Tobit. There, he guides Tobit's son, Tobiah, through a series of fantastic adventures that lead to a three-fold happy ending: Tobiah's marriage to Sarah, the healing of Tobit's blindness, and the restoration of the family fortune. Each archangel performs a different mission in Scripture: Michael protects; Gabriel announces; Raphael guides.

# Cooking Together: Blackberry Cobbler

Legend tells us that when St. Michael kicked Lucifer out of Heaven, Lucifer landed in a bed of thorny blackberry bushes!

#### **Ingredients**

- 4 cups fresh blackberries
- 1 Tbsp lemon juice
- 1 large egg
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 6 Tbsp butter, melted

Whipped cream (optional)

Garnish: fresh mint sprig

#### **Instructions**

Preheat oven to 375 F. Place blackberries in a lightly greased 8-inch square baking dish; sprinkle with lemon juice. Stir together egg, sugar, and flour in a medium bowl until the mixture resembles coarse meal. Sprinkle over fruit. Drizzle melted butter over topping. Bake at 375 F for 35 minutes or until lightly browned and bubbly. Let stand 10 minutes. Serve warm with whipped cream, if desired. Garnish with fresh mint sprig, if desired.


## In Loving Memory of Fr. David Dixon
