

THE CALL OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

My prayer is for all of us to be renewed in spirit, to listen to our hearts, to claim our common goal together as a family, and to support everyone's efforts toward making Archangel Gabriel Parish fully alive in the Lord.





At the end of the Choices Pregnancy Walk for Life on Saturday, May 13, Keri Muir of Choices praised God that this was their most successful Walk for Life ever (their 30th) with contributions totaling \$105,798!

In recognizing the top individual fundraisers and teams, they giggled at the fact that the top two teams were from Archangel Gabriel Parish, and they were anxious to see if the Knights of Columbus group would overtake Archangel Gabriel Respect Life group - they did not. It was close, but in the end, our parish managed together to raise \$11,370 (Respect Life \$6,100 + Knights \$5,270), far surpassing last year's record of \$6,890. EXPLORING OUR FAITH

Pentecost Sunday

The Sunday Gospel

John 20:19-23

Pentecost is sometimes called the birthday of the Church. The Gospel for Pentecost reminds us that the Church begins with the command to forgive. Within the family, the domestic Church, we learn how to forgive and how to accept forgiveness. The gift of the Holy Spirit enables us to do both. Today is a fitting time to share a family celebration of reconciliation.

Jesus appears to his disciples and gives them the gift of the Holy Spirit.

As you gather together as a family, sit quietly for a few minutes, inviting everyone to reflect upon their need to forgive and to receive forgiveness. If there is a situation or an issue within the family that needs attention, spend some time reflecting on how your family might address it. Read together today's Gospel, John 20:19-23. Talk together about how Jesus gave us the gift of the Holy Spirit to help us in the work of forgiveness and to bring us peace. Pray together today's Psalm or the Prayer to the Holy Spirit, asking that the Holy Spirit help your family. Share with one another a Sign of Peace.

Our Extended Family

St. Elizabeth, Cousin of Mary Feast Day: November 5 First Century

May 31 is the feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It recalls the time when the Blessed Mother visited Elizabeth. Elizabeth was pregnant with John the Baptist, and Mary was pregnant with Jesus. Elizabeth, a daughter of the line of Aaron, and the wife of Zechariah, was "righteous before God" but childless and well beyond child-bearing age. The angel Gabriel told Zechariah that Elizabeth would have a son, and they should name him John. When Mary visited Elizabeth, Elizabeth's baby leaped in her womb! Jesus made John leap with joy, and Elizabeth, in turn, was filled with the Holy Spirit and addressed words of praise to Mary—words that echoed down through the ages in the Hail Mary prayer.



Pentecost Q&A

Why does the priest wear red vestments at Pentecost?

The red vestments are symbolic of the burning fire of God's love and the tongues of fire that descended on the apostles.

When is Pentecost?

Pentecost always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and ten days after his ascension into heaven.

The timing of these feasts is also where Catholics get the concept of the Novena - nine days of prayer - because in Acts 1, Mary and the Apostles prayed together "continuously" for nine days after the Ascension leading up to Pentecost. Traditionally, the Church prays the Novena to the Holy Spirit in the days before Pentecost.

What are we celebrating at Pentecost?

In the Christian tradition, Pentecost is the celebration of the person of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Mary, and the first followers of Jesus, who were gathered together in the Upper Room. A "strong, driving" wind filled the room where they were gathered, and tongues of fire came to rest on their heads, allowing them to speak in different languages. The Holy Spirit also gave the apostles the other gifts and fruits necessary to fulfill the great commission - to go out and preach the Gospel to all nations.

Why is Pentecost considered the birthday of the Church?

It was right after Pentecost that Peter, inspired by the Holy Spirit, preached his first homily to Jews and other non-believers. According to Acts, about 3,000 people were baptized following Peter's sermon. For this reason, Pentecost is considered the birthday of the Church - Peter, the first Pope, preaches for the first time and converts thousands of new believers. The apostles and believers, for the first time, were united by a common zeal and purpose to go and preach the Gospel.

Cooking Together: Red Velvet Butter Cookies

Red is the liturgical color of Pentecost. Treat your family with this delicious recipe!

Ingredients

1/2 cup butter, softened
8 ounces cream cheese, softened
1 large egg
1/2 cup powdered sugar
1 tsp pure vanilla extract
1 package Red Velvet Cake Mix
1/2 cup white chocolate chips

Instructions

Preheat oven to 350 F. Use an electric mixer to combine the butter and cream cheese in a large bowl until the mixture is fluffy. Add the egg and the vanilla. Mix until fully combined. Add the cake mix and continue to mix until a thick dough forms.

Fold in the chocolate chips. Place the powdered sugar in a small bowl. Form 1-inch dough balls and roll in the powdered sugar to coat.

Place cookies 2 inches apart on a cookie sheet lined with parchment paper. Bake for 10 to 12 minutes.

Cool the cookies on a wire rack.
Once cooled, dust the cookies with powdered sugar.
