# A MESSAGE FROM OUR CLERGY

#### BEING FED BY THE WORD OF CHRIST

The crowds gathered to be fed by the Word of Christ, a different message compelling them to leave behind the empty experience of their present faith life. Because what they were receiving before Jesus wasn't feeding them, we find them today arriving exhausted and utterly spent. Jesus notices and asks the disciples to beg God for more ministers of word and sacrament to hear the call to serve and to answer that call.

We are happy to say that there are three young men who will be ordained to the priesthood this upcoming Saturday, including our own Deacon Jacob Gruber. We know his family has answered the call as Jacob will be the third priest from his family. While the rest of us ponder what specific call the Lord is asking us to answer, we look for answers our people provide us with to show how they are doing just that.

I wrote last month about the results from the DMI survey coming to us by the end of May. As of this writing (June 1st) they came in one week ago. (Due to vacations and scheduling, we had to prepare five bulletins in advance through the first weekend of July which is no easy task!) What we received were twelve reports organized into three sections. Each of these takes into consideration the 79 questions you answered. The volume of information is huge and there is no way to arrange that much information to you at one time. We have an Envisioning Team who will be diving into these reports with me to see how best we can present them to you and to explain their meaning to you. By the time we get a handle on this, we will be in mid-summer at the earliest. Please be patient with our unpacking of this material. This team will begin meeting formally in mid-August, and we will continue to do so through at least mid-January 2024. Please pray for us and for the inspiration of the Holy Spirit to guide us and our advisor from Catholic Leadership Institute, who will be with us to build our Next Generation Parish vision in the next three to four years.




## SHRINES OF WISCONSIN PILGRIMAGE
