HOW ARE YOU MODELING THE LOVE OF CHRIST?

Do you feel Him loving you? When you do, are you sharing with others what that experience is like? The moment you are caught by Christ, what do you feel compelled to do? This faith experience is what Paul is talking about to his people in Thessalonica. He, Silvanus, and Timothy began this letter to them in a warm, welcoming fashion as we heard last week. So soon has this ministry started among them that the people did not hesitate to share their good news with neighboring communities. Those communities related this back to Paul. There is a deep sense of pride in Paul as he rejoices with the Holy Spirit on their behalf.

Any good shepherd would praise his people for living out the Gospel! This is Christ speaking through them, prompting them to love their neighbor by sharing how the Good News has touched their hearts! Jesus reached out to the many and called a


smaller number to be His disciples. From this smaller number a ministry of evangelization is born as each of these disciples reach out to many and inspire the few to continue in their stead. As the number of disciples grew, an embrace of missionary zeal urged them to imitate this way of Christ.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Sunday, November 5 Holy Trinity Church During the 12:30 PM Mass

A celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will take place during the 12:30 PM Mass at Holy Trinity Church on Sunday, November 5. The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. Hence, as soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness, upcoming surgery, or old age, the fitting time for them to receive this sacrament has certainly arrived. When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be in God's will, the person will be healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age. The Anointing of the Sick is one of two sacraments of healing, the other being the Sacrament of Reconciliation.



PENNSYLVANIA STATE MARCH FOR LIFE

There was a great turnout for the PA March for Life on Monday, October 16. The speakers made some outstanding points:

- From Dr. Kendra Kolb, a Neonatologist: A baby can suck its thumb as early as 7 weeks; it feels pain at 15 weeks; and outside the womb, babies can survive at 22 weeks with medical assistance. Current PA law allows abortion up to 24 weeks.
- 47 out of 50 European countries limit abortion at 15 weeks.
- One couple showed great appreciation for a Harrisburg area Pregnancy Center that they said gave them a "hand-up and not a hand-out." The father said he had a major turnaround in accepting his responsibility after being invited to a Pizza night with men in similar situations. The couple held their baby during their speeches. This pregnancy center is set to lose funding with Governor Shapiro's termination of state funding for pro-life pregnancy centers.



ST. RAPHAEL HOLIDAY CRAFT SHOW


