

A MESSAGE FROM OUR CLERGY

LEADING THE WAY THROUGH SERVICE

The love of God reaches out to us by the hand of our Archangel Gabriel. In gratitude, we welcome such an extension! Who wouldn't want to receive a gift from the Lord? We feel chosen and special and even humbled that God would choose to bring us His message. Over the past three evenings of our Archangel Triduum, we heard Fr. Blau expound upon the wonders of the Eucharist in the Sacred Scriptures and in our liturgical practices today. The thread of God's intervention connects all three presentations and presents to us an opportunity. Act on the message you have received!

Gabriel brought news of great joy in his visit to our Blessed Mother. She asked for understanding so she could carry out the mission she was given. We have been called to be missionary disciples not in theory, but in fact and in action. We sent out to you in my missive last week the link to join our effort to care for the most in need and we

are praying you will answer that call with the same spirit of love as our Blessed Mother Mary did. I would also like to ask our membership in the other service-oriented ministries to share their love for people in need by offering their assistance as well.

Inviting and leading others by example can help each group fulfill their mission and build closer bonds across the parish and community. Let's send the message of how much we care for our neighbors by leading the way in love through service.

Next weekend we will be celebrating the Rite of Welcoming for all candidates for Reception into Full Communion and for the completion of their Sacraments of Initiation. Please pray for them and all others discerning their journey into / with the Catholic faith at the 10:00 AM Mass at Holy Trinity Church.





THE NOCTURNAL ADORATION SOCIETY

The NAS is a national Catholic ministry that meets locally at St. Margaret of Scotland Church, and is dedicated to prayer before the Eucharist for the praise of God and for the needs of the world. Membership requires one thing only: to spend one hour, once a month, during the hours of the night, in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament exposed on the Altar.

To ensure that the Blessed Sacrament is never left alone, NAS members are arranged in groups that rotate between different hours each month. We adore, pray communally, read from the Old and New Testaments, and have quiet time for personal prayer. Adoration hours begin at 10:00 PM, the first Friday of each month, and ends with Benediction at 7:00 AM on Saturday.

Nocturnal Adoration offers a unique opportunity to be in the presence of Jesus at a time when there are no distractions; to meditate on His passion, death, and resurrection; to pray with Him to our Father; and to receive the strength of the Holy Spirit to continue His mission of love and compassion. Members pray for the intentions of Nocturnal Adoration Society members worldwide, for world peace, pro-life issues, vocations, victims of war and natural disasters, and our departed brothers and sisters. Any parishioner of any parish is welcome to come to any hour(s) and participate in this profound liturgy. 
