A MESSAGE FROM OUR CLERGY

REALIZING OUR POTENTIAL

The Lord sees in us tremendous potential. The difference between that potential being seen and being acted on is a bridge for us to cross. As a bridge is a means by which we travel over a chasm, so is our spirituality a means to realize our potential. Many times we operate with our God-given talents and faculties, but there is a limit to them. Jesus is offering us a way to go beyond our human limitations and to discover what is possible when we rely on Him. This reliance is not a matter of sitting back and letting God do what He wants. This is a spiritual partnership with our human nature that goes beyond what our nature can reach. When we feel this connection, there is a profound peace in us. This is the spirit of the worthy wife in our first reading from the Book of Proverbs. This spirit also flows from her and envelops her husband who entrusts his heart to her.

When I prepare couples for marriage I tell them you don't come as one person alone and you don't come together only as a couple, you always come together as three persons with the Lord in your midst. This tells us the communication shared is not a dialogue but a triologue. By virtue of the active participation of Christ, that communication always involves prayer. The more deeply we enter into that prayer between the three, the more the love of God fills you with a peace not possible by human nature alone. When we do not trust that three-fold relationship, we are embraced by our limitations which lead us to errors of mind and heart. Consequences arise when we rely on ourselves. The parable to the disciples shows this. The richness referred to here comes from the bond of unity. The little one thinks about what one has is taken away because our human nature by itself is prone to weakness and cannot handle losing the little it thinks it has. Our call is to be strong with the Lord and to resist the temptation to live life without Him.

We celebrate with great joy our candidates received into full communion with the Roman Catholic Church at the 10:00 AM Mass next Sunday. Please pray for their joy in the Lord!








KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS OCTOBER 2023 FAMILY SPOTLIGHT: JOHN AND LINDA VIRGI






