WHAT IS NEXT?

Mark gets to the point quickly: "Before I tell you about Jesus, I am going to tell you about who pointed Him out to you." John the Baptist begins this gospel, so there is no question of how the ministry of Christ begins. The role of John is two-fold. He first proclaims a new message that embraces a new spiritual life through a new passage from what is to what will be. Baptism cleanses, redeems, and renews the soul. This is the first offering of unconditional love from God. Beginning with mercy, followed by forgiveness, and then invited into a renewed relationship with the Lord, John now points to Jesus as the Word. The newly baptized in the Jordan River are eager for what is next.

The second role of John is to convince them that they should look no further than the Christ. Baptizing was easier, novel, and attention-grabbing. Convincing the public that John isn't the Messiah is much harder. John doesn't shy away from the challenge.

He even directs his followers to abandon him. The truth is more important than the notoriety. With prayer, John accepts his role, knowing it will diminish in time. He rejoices in the ministry of Jesus and even more so that his disciples have found "what is next" in Christ.

In this Second Sunday of Advent we should be looking for what Jesus has lined up for us. He first needs us to get the message of repentance so He can fill our hearts with the joy of discovery. Discover how deeply satisfying an intense relationship with the Lord is! The light of dawn gives way to the sunrise. The shadowy images in the first hours of the morning disappear to reveal where Christ is active in our lives today! This Wednesday, the Light is on for You for reconciliation. We will be offering confessions at Holy Trinity Church from 5:30 PM - 9:00 PM. After the 6:30 PM Mass, we will have a prayer service with intermittent music so the spirit of prayer will embrace all those who gather with us.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD AT ARCHANGEL GABRIEL PARISH

AGP celebrates the Liturgy of the Word with children during the 10:00AM Sunday Mass at Holy Trinity Church, except when the heavenly voices of our children's choir are singing. Led by Pat Kulak and Christa Gerlowski, this ministry has been growing and now averages 14 children per week, with as many as 30 attending in recent weeks. During our time with the children, we follow the same Liturgy of the Word that the rest of the Mass participants do, but in a manner that children can easily understand. We share an opening prayer, take time to say we are sorry for our sins, and sing the Gospel acclamation, including the version that Fr. Lou uses during school Masses. The Gospel is proclaimed in age-appropriate words to promote understanding and a love of the Word. The leader then guides the children through the homily, retelling the Gospel story and discussing how to incorporate that message into their daily lives. The children respond to questions and demonstrate their understanding through activities, such as drawing. We have recently begun to sing the Creed, which the children love. We close with the universal prayers and then joyfully return to our families, eager to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist. If your child is in Kindergarten through Grade 2, we encourage them to come and experience this special time with God and their peers!

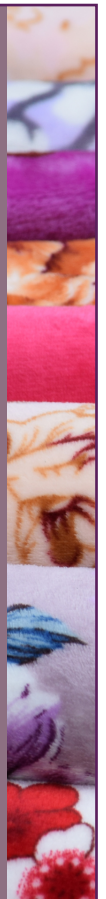
Also, we will make haluski this week. Remember to call early to order your haluski; this Friday is the last day we will feature it on our menu.
