#### AN INVITATION TO PRAISE HIM

Isaiah rejoices in being chosen by God, a designation for a holy purpose. He says he has been anointed, which is also a sign of approval that the work he does for the Lord is intended to lift up the people of God. In whatever state of life we find ourselves, we are all invited to give praise to Him for "a year of favor from the Lord and a day of vindication by our God" has been announced to us! Isaiah invites us to join our spirit with his and to celebrate the approaching closeness of Christ. This Third Sunday of Advent makes the meaning of the message feel much closer to our hearts. The birth of Jesus will be upon us in just over a week. How joyful is your soul? The soul of Isaiah rejoices heartily in the Lord as he feels the protection of God's presence. He feels the movement of God prompting justice and praise to spring up before all the nations. We need to feel that movement of God today as well.

As the Pharisees sent priests and Levites to John the Baptist at the Jordan River to find out who he was and why he was baptizing the people, another proclamation of praise to God comes forth. John directs them to One who is to come, who will touch our lives more deeply than any holy use of water. He wants to transform your life with His life in you! Therefore, listen to Paul in his letter telling us to "rejoice always, never cease praying, and render constant thanks, for such is God's will for you in Christ Jesus". With the strength of such a joy-filled spirit, there is no room for doubt in our hearts. Paul wishes us to feel the peace of God making us perfect in holiness. He will preserve us from all that draws us away from Him.




