### FINDING BALANCE AND MAKING ROOM FOR CHRIST

Ritual and practice, routine and regularity, expectations and performance are all part of patterns that we teach for some good purpose. What makes these difficult to get across is the increasing number of variables that interfere with our decision-making. More than most, parents go through this every day. Though the environment is different, managing any large organization goes through similar twists and turns. With myriad options on the table, relying on what always worked before may not cut it anymore. These references show our human limitations and expose our frustrations. To remove ourselves from these obstacles, we have to step back and refocus on what isn't being employed often enough. It's our spiritual life.

It is so easy to rely on human strength, knowledge and experience. We are not looking to God for answers, and we are not slowing down or listening for His response. If we are finding ourselves so involved with a large number of activities and commitments,

is it all that surprising we don't have time to spend with each other, let alone with Christ? Where is our family balance? How are we supporting each other at home, at school, or at work? When are we going to recognize that our not feeling satisfied or not feeling settled inside is due to our overload of choices and our lack of prayer time with the Lord?

Ritual met holiness in Simeon and Anna today. Joseph and Mary marveled at what was said about Jesus because the love of God through these two witnesses filled them with so much joy. They had balance in their lives and, therefore, did not miss the divine gift of prophecy and testimony. They knew God was speaking to them. They had ample room in their hearts and lives for Him. As we are called to be holy families, let's make room for the love that can bring us peace.

Finally, thank you to all who worked so hard to decorate our churches for Christmas. Your time and talent are much appreciated, and the churches looked beautiful to honor the Nativity of our Lord.

### RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

RCIA at Archangel Gabriel Parish serves adults who are seeking any of the sacraments of initiation - Baptism, Eucharist, and/or Confirmation. We offer RCIA on a year-round basis, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit so that individuals who are already baptized (Candidates) may receive their sacraments throughout the year. Those who are unbaptized (Catechumens) are also welcome to join RCIA at any time, and would receive all three sacraments of initiation at the following Easter Vigil (at least one year of preparation).

Our next RCIA cohort will begin on **January 21, 2024**. Individual intake sessions to prepare for that cohort will be held on **Sunday, January 7**, and **Sunday, January 14**. 

Come make a warm blanket to donate to those without a home. We will be donating these blankets to the Pleasant Valley Men's Shelter located on Pittsburgh's North Side.





### **SENSORY FRIENDLY MASS**

In an effort to make Mass more welcoming to adults and children with disabilities, particularly those with sensory processing disorders, Archangel Gabriel Parish is hosting a monthly Sensory Friendly Mass. Adaptations include dimmer lights, no music, no incense, lower volume on microphones, availability of low-gluten hosts, and shorter, more literal homilies. In addition, we invite families and individuals to get up and move if needed, to bring alternative seating, fidgets, and/or noise cancelling headphones, and to participate in the liturgy just as they are.




