Over the next eight weeks, the Catholic Leadership Institute will input the paper surveys and prepare a detailed analysis of the survey results. We expect to have these results in by the end of May. In the meantime, members of the Parish Pastoral Council and Executive Team will begin reviewing and updating the Pastoral Plan that was prepared three years ago in preparation for our work on a new Pastoral Plan, which we hope to draft this fall.








Members of the AGP Respect Life Group prayed in front of Planned Parenthood on March 25 as part of the 40 Days for Life Lenten Campaign. We had two first-timers participating, and when we arrived, we found Planned Parenthood CLOSED!! That is unusual for a Saturday morning. A woman walked by and thanked us for being there, saying that 40 years ago, she walked up to the clinic and changed her mind about having an abortion after a counselor gave her information with helpful options. She told our group several times not to get discouraged and to keep up what we are doing. Her daughter is 40 years old now. We quietly prayed on the street (Rosary and more), and I know many of you were praying from home. Thank you to those that said special prayers and to those who continue to pray their daily Decade for Life as part of the Living Rosary. Let's keep praying and working to help the pregnancy centers that are there to offer women a helping hand.

Service of Love - Prayer Blanket Ministry

EXPLORING OUR FAITH

The Resurrection of the Lord

The Sunday Gospel

John 20:1-9

In the Easter Gospel we hear about how the disciples found the tomb empty three days after Jesus' death. We are also told that they do not yet understand the Scriptures or that Jesus had been raised from the dead. That understanding gradually unfolded for the disciples as they began to experience the risen Lord. Similarly, our understanding of Jesus' Resurrection unfolds for us throughout our lives. In the weeks ahead, we will hear how the first disciples moved from

confusion, doubt, and skepticism to faith. Their experience can teach us how we too might receive this gift of faith from God.

Gather your family members and ask them to share what they know about the events that happened in the days after Jesus' crucifixion. Invite your family to imagine that they are among Jesus' first disciples. Read together today's Gospel, John 20:1-9. Reflect together on the Gospel with questions such as these: If you had been among the first disciples who heard that the stone had been removed from Jesus' tomb and that Jesus' body was no longer there, what would you think? What did Mary of Magdala, Simon Peter, and the disciple whom Jesus loved think had happened? Recall that this experience is the first indication Jesus' disciples have that he is risen. Throughout the Easter season, we will learn more about how the disciples came to believe that Jesus had been raised from the dead.

Pray together using today's psalm, Psalm 118: "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad."

- Why is Easter the most important holiday we celebrate as Christians?
- What is Mary Magdalene's reaction when Jesus appears? What would yours be if you were in her shoes?
- Discuss the range of emotions Jesus' followers must have felt on Holy Saturday vs. Easter Sunday.

Our Extended Family

St. Mary Magdalene (Feast Day July 22) First Century



Mary Magdalene, or Mary of Magdala, was a friend and follower of Jesus. The Gospel of Luke tells us that Jesus cast out "seven demons" from her, and, throughout the Gospel, we hear how she was present with Jesus and the Twelve Apostles. She stood next to Mary, the Mother of Jesus, at the foot of the cross. Mary Magdalene was the first person to whom Jesus appeared after he was resurrected. She is sometimes called the "Apostle to the Apostles" because she was sent to tell the other apostles the good news of Christ's resurrection. She is the patron saint of many things, including contemplative life, penitent sinners, perfumeries, and women.

Cooking Together: Egg and Sausage Casserole

Mary Magdalene ran to the tomb of Christ early in the morning. Enjoy this breakfast dish on Easter morning!

2½ cups of Rice Krispies

1 pound of ground sausage (Italian or Turkey)

1 small onion

1 cup cooked rice (brown or white)

2 cups sharp cheddar cheese

6 eggs

2 cans Cream of Mushroom soup (can use Cream of Chicken)
1/4 cup milk

Preheat oven to 350 F. Grease a 9x13 pan (or use cooking spray). Cover the baking dish with the Rice Krispies. Brown the sausage and drain. Chop the onions. Spread the sausage and onions over the Rice Krispies. Cover with the cooked rice. Spread cheese over the rice. Combine eggs, soup, and milk. Stir well and spread over the cheese. For garnish, sprinkle with additional Rice Krispies. Bake for 50 minutes.
