EXCHANGING THE TEMPORAL FOR THE ETERNAL

Exchange the temporal for the eternal. In a quick theme, that is what underlies our readings today. We know our time here is temporary and heaven is forever, but there still feels like a chasm between one and the other and we are unsure of how we can travel that bridge with confident faith. We are not even sure our effort is enough to get us across to the other side. We hesitate and stop, and the distance between the two points remains too long for us to try. The worry overtakes us, because we are relying only on our capacity to achieve. We forget how limited that capacity is and that we are intentionally made this way to fulfill a higher plan and purpose.

Look at the reminders of this in what we have just heard. The word of God goes forth, it does not return to Him void and that word does His will, thus achieving the goal for which He sent it. The delivery is from Him, through Him, and for Him and us. We

benefit while He provides. The struggles of the present are nothing compared to the glory to be revealed in us. As hard as it seems that our worst conflicts continue to press down our hope, the blessings of God exceed all we have ever feared. The yield from the soil does not depend on how hard we work or what methods we use. It is frustrating not to have control over this, yet we know God still needs us to play a part in His saving grace. The explanation to the disciples at first sounds negative, but instead it is inspirational in intent. What sight, hearing, and understanding we use is all limited and unfruitful if we don't use the sight, hearing, and understanding of God to get His message. When that choice is made, we turn to Him with our whole hearts, and He will heal us from all that holds us back in this temporal life.

This same exchange from our capacity to that of God will enable us to grasp the spiritual intention of our coming together as one family, to choose it, and to cooperate with the bolder, broader vision of God for us in the Next Generation Parish of Archangel Gabriel.




SUMMER READING CAMP
