A MESSAGE FROM OUR CLERGY



THE FRUITS OF GENEROSITY

What will your generosity produce? We have no way of knowing. Why bother? We know why, because our conscience will not stop reminding us of the good we can do. Provided that we examine and exercise our conscience, it will always be there to help us make the best decisions for us and for others. There is also a natural desire to do good wherever possible, because that is our response to the Lord who planted that desire in our hearts. We would be denying Him in us if we said that desire doesn't exist in us. There are times when we tamp down that urge to do good. That is when we are motivated by desires, not of God but of a much lesser quality. The urge to do for others is replaced by the urge to serve oneself.

Look at the woman in the first reading. She knew what she most desired - to be a mother - but she didn't let that get in the way of her heart in providing for Elisha.

As the prophet foretold, God remembers such generosity and blesses abundantly. Her desire for a child was certainly good. Her call to serve drew from a greater source, one who provided her with both the blessing of a fond relationship and a son. That sense of proportion in favor of God's design ahead of ours also releases a trust in God's providence, a spiritual gift. This encapsules the teaching of Jesus in the gospel to His apostles.

This experience of God and the blessings He gives are both very real. I ask and pray we refer to this as we move forward in our discernment of what the Next Generation Parish of Archangel Gabriel will look like in this perspective. The envisioning process will move to the implementation process where we will put our discernment to the test. Our new Pastoral Plan will not only lay the foundation but also enlist the makers of new disciples to carry out the work of realizing God's vision for us. That will certainly include deep prayer, open discussion, and spiritual consensus of our people in order for this vision to become reality. That reality must be welcoming, flexible, and accommodating to whomever is, or wants to be, a part of our parish life.

Children's Liturgy of the Word

AGP is starting a Children's Liturgy of the Word ministry (CLW) this fall. CLW is a liturgical celebration that takes place during regular Sunday Mass. Children in Kindergarten through second grade go with the CLW adult leader to hear the Readings and Gospel proclaimed in terms appropriate for young children. The Scriptures are then discussed so that the children have a better understanding of the message. Following the discussion, the children rejoin their families at Mass for the Liturgy of the Eucharist.




