

THE MIGHT OF GOD IS SHOWN IN HIS LOVE


The might of God is shown in His love and the love of God is shown in His might. The book of Wisdom shares with us the expanse of God's desire to not only govern with justice but to also show kindness through justice. Those who are just must be kind, not just in their nature but also in how they distribute justice. Vindictiveness has crept into society as a measure of how we feel coming out of an experience of being hurt. No healing takes place for either side. There are enough examples of how a different way of thinking predominated among the wise internationalists of 19th century Europe. In the time of Bismark, chancellor of Germany, there was a policy practiced by the victors in war that reached out to the vanquished and helped them to remain a productive member of global society. The reason behind this, put simply, was to see the bigger picture of former enemies needing each other down the road. Circumstances and players on the world stage change. What was important yesterday may no longer be so

tomorrow. What was envisioned today may never have been thought of before.

The Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness, supporting us when we are not so strong. The same help comes to us in our strength, teaching us to be generous and kind so that unity matters far more than winners and losers. We all want to plant good seeds for the future, and we know we are sharing the same ground with others who till the soil with us. Working together for a common harvest shows our wisdom as we cultivate missionary disciples for the Lord.

WELCOME FR. CARMEN D'AMICO

My Brothers and Sisters of Archangel Gabriel Parish, here is a little bit about me. I was born in Pittsburgh on January 3, 1955, son of the late Anthony and Mary Semplice-D'Amico. I am the youngest of four children. I grew up in Brookline and attended Our Lady of Loreto Elementary School, South Hills Catholic High School, CCAC, the University of Pittsburgh, and Duquesne University, where I received a B.A. in U.S. History in 1978. I attended St. Paul Seminary in Pittsburgh and Mount Saint Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, MD. I was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Pittsburgh on June 26, 1982. I was parochial vicar at Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish in Ellwood City, PA (1982-87) and parochial vicar at St. Paul Cathedral (1987-91) before becoming pastor of St. Benedict the Moor Parish in the Hill District (1991-2011). During that time, I also became administrator of the Church of Epiphany in 2003 and was named pastor in 2006 and administrator of St. Mary of Mercy Parish in 2008. While at St. Benedict, I founded AJAPO (Acculturation, Justice, Access, and Peace Outreach)

which assists refugees and immigrants from Africa, the Afro-Caribbean Islands, and other immigrant/refugee populations. I became pastor of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal Parish in Meadowlands (2011-20). During that time, the parish became the center of worship, religious education, and social services for the Latino Community in Washington County. I served for two years as administrator of the parishes of St. Patrick in Canonsburg, Holy Rosary in Muse, and Miraculous Medal, which became Oscar Romero Parish, where I served as pastor from 2020-July 10, 2023. It is with great joy that I have been called to serve as Senior Parochial Vicar here at Archangel Gabriel Parish. I have a passion for learning about the culture of others, and I look forward to learning more about our parish and the communities that we are called to minister to and serve. I truly believe that our cultural diversity is a reflection of the majesty and greatness of our God.

A MESSAGE FROM THE DIOCESE OF PITTSBURGH REGARDING

PASTORAL PLANNING The pastoral planning process, including the Disciple Maker Inventory that many of you completed earlier this year, is happening in parishes across the Diocese of Pittsburgh. There are three tracks for this program - Next Generation Parish, Virtual, and Self-Directed. Each parish follows their own timeline, but all will deliver a parish pastoral plan to Bishop Zubik on or before February 14, 2024.

The **Next Generation Parish (NGP)** Track is a four-year experience that includes accompaniment and guidance from the Catholic Leadership Institute as the pastor and his community assess the parish's greatest opportunities and strengths; develop a plan to move into the future with hope; and cultivate a deeper missionary spirit throughout the community. Twenty-three of our parishes have elected to participate in the Next Generation Parish.




Parishes participating in the **Virtual Track** receive four individualized virtual tutorials from the Catholic Leadership Institute that assist parishes with understanding the DMI results and creating a pastoral plan with priorities and goals. In this track, parishes will be responsible for creating their own implementation strategies. Fifteen of our parishes elected to participate in this track.

Parishes participating in the **Self-Directed Track** have been participating in group webinars to assist with reviewing and understanding the DMI results. Through the use of templates, these parishes will self-direct the writing of their pastoral plans and be responsible for creating implementation strategies. Twenty three of our parishes elected to participate in this track.

DMI Results - Regardless of what track your parish is following (NGP, Virtual, or Self-Directed) we know that many parishioners are requesting to see the Disciple Maker Index results. While it is encouraging that so many are interested in seeing the results, we must also keep in mind that it takes time for the pastor and key parish leaders to learn how to navigate the CLI portal and assess the information that is voluminous and detailed.

In order to give ample time for all parishes to prepare for the distribution of results and to ensure that all parishes are receiving information in a consistent manner, a universal distribution date for DMI results has been established for the weekend of August 19/20, 2023. All parishes in the diocese will use a common template to publish their individual results, and the aggregate results for the entire parish will be published in parish bulletins during the weekend of August 26/27, 2023.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Sunday, July 30 St. Malachy Church During the 8:00 AM Mass

A celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will take place during the 8:00 AM Mass at St. Malachy Church on Sunday, July 30. The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. Hence, as soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness, upcoming surgery, or old age, the fitting time for them to receive this sacrament has certainly arrived. When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be in God's will, the person will be healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age. The Anointing of the Sick is one of two sacraments of healing, the other being the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
