## UPDATES ON THE AGP PRESCHOOL & NURSERY AND ST. MARY, HELP OF CHRISTIANS CHURCH

Since I assumed the role of Parish Administrator in December 2022, one of my top priorities has been the evaluation of the parish's ministries and resources and working toward ensuring that they best serve the people in our care. I consider the Archangel Gabriel Parish Preschool & Nursery, which provides faith-based childcare and education to our families and children, essential to the ministry and mission of the parish. To this end, we have been working with a consultant with extensive experience in childcare facilities and their operations. This short-term arrangement is meant to provide professional support as we examine the potential for growth and enhancements of the programs we offer.

Over the past few weeks, there has been much speculation about the operations at Archangel Gabriel Preschool & Nursery. Quality childcare is difficult to find and there has been understandable concern over the status of the school and its leadership that has led to confusion and frustration. In addition, some misinformation has been circulated that has also complicated communications.

Please let me assure you that I am committed to the continuation and growth of the Archangel Gabriel Parish Preschool & Nursery. As more families continue to seek compassionate, faith-based care for their children, we are laying the groundwork for the growth of this ministry and are in the midst of a search for candidates for both leadership and classroom opportunities to support the talented and dedicated educators and caregivers already in place.

Another issue I wish to address is the current closure of the front entrances of St. Mary, Help of Christians Church. This is directly related to concerns about the safety of the stained-glass, rose window located directly above these entrances. Pieces of the window framing have fallen off, and although the pieces have been small, they pose a safety risk. We have been consulting with engineers and restoration companies about the status of the window and are awaiting direction about how to proceed. In the meantime, a scaffolding will be constructed to provide protection for those attending church. We will work to keep you updated as the situation develops.

Thank you for your patience and your prayers as we work to rectify both of these situations.

## A MESSAGE FROM THE DIOCESE OF PITTSBURGH REGARDING PASTORAL PLANNING - ENVISIONING TEAM AND PURPOSE

An essential step before beginning a pastoral plan is to establish a parish Envisioning Team consisting of five to seven members. This team will assist Father Alan with analyzing the results of the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) Survey and in the creation of a pastoral plan. A pastoral plan lays the path for how best the parish is going to achieve its mission and lead parishioners in furthering our call to Jesus and our ability to lead others to Jesus.

The Church teaches that the purpose of the parish is to proclaim the Gospel, celebrate the Sacraments, and promote works of charity, all directed towards the salvation of souls. The process of pastoral planning will allow us to bring this purpose to life as we strive to live out the mission entrusted to the Church by Christ: "Go into the whole world and proclaim the Good News to all of creation." (Mark 16:15).



As a reminder, in order to give ample time for all parishes to prepare for the distribution of DMI results and to ensure that all parishes are receiving information in a consistent manner, a universal distribution date for DMI results has been established for the weekend of August 19/20, 2023. All parishes in the diocese will use a common template to publish their individual results. Aggregate results for the entire diocese will be published in parish bulletins the weekend of August 26/27, 2023.

## MISSIONARY COOPERATIVE APPEAL: SECOND COLLECTION | AUGUST 5/6, 2023

Every year the Diocese of Pittsburgh, along with all the Dioceses of the United States, participates in the Missionary Cooperative Appeal. It's an opportunity for us to remember our calling to perform missionary work in conjunction with the Church. This year, on August 6, Fr. Adrian Zikambona will speak at Masses about the Sisters of Charity of St. Charles Borromeo in Tanzania and their work with people who are poor and marginalized. The second collection on August 6 will support the Sisters' ministries, including:

- Orphanage centers to care for the growing number of orphans because of HIV/AIDS and other diseases.
- Schools and financial support for the education of orphans and adolescent girls from poor families whose parents might otherwise arrange a marriage to receive the bride price (a custom dowry of animals) from the groom and his family.
- The drilling of wells to provide local sources of clean water.
- Health care centers in villages that provide medication and pastoral care for the sick, including the victims of HIV/AIDS.





Thank you in advance for your generosity in both prayer and financial support for the people of Tanzania and in all mission territories throughout the world where the Church is present to offer spiritual and material assistance to God's people.

#### ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Sunday, July 30 St. Malachy Church During the 8:00 AM Mass

A celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will take place during the 8:00 AM Mass at St. Malachy Church on Sunday, July 30. The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. Hence, as soon as anyone begins to be in danger of death from sickness, upcoming surgery, or old age, the fitting time for them to receive this sacrament has certainly arrived. When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be in God's will, the person will be healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age. The Anointing of the Sick is one of two sacraments of healing, the other being the Sacrament of Reconciliation.




