#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR CLERGY

#### TREADING ON TURBULENT WATERS

Before we look at the gospel for today, we need to visit the passage in Matthew that would have been proclaimed for us last week had it not been the feast of the Transfiguration. Three times Jesus experienced a mark of sadness in His heart. First, there is the death of John the Baptist; the one who announced the coming of the Messiah is martyred for proclaiming the truth. Before Christ can mourn the loss of the prophet, and despite the need to be in a deserted place for some much-needed rest, the crowds find them again. The needs of the people trump the need of the few and, in His tiredness, the heart of Jesus hurts for a people who keep coming to take and have not learned how to give from what they have received. Lastly, the inability of His closest friends to accept both the opportunity to serve and the trust in the One who provides seems to almost deflate Jesus at the same time, so He gives of Himself again.

Looking at this backdrop, it appears Jesus is finally able to get what He needs while sending the disciples ahead of Him by boat to the opposite shore. Let's not lose the significance of time here. Day has turned to night. At three in the morning, Christ walks out to the disciples as they are tossed about by waves. This is strength coming to us in our time of weakness. Even when we cry out from our weakness, He answers us with His never-failing love. That love enables us to tread on turbulent waters as our only focus remains on our Savior. Peter lost his focus, began to sink, and cried out for Christ. So do we.

Even though the drama with this nighttime scene is obvious, the turbulent times in our lives are not always so to us. Next weekend we will hear short testimonies from parishioners about their experience of Alpha and their invitation to come and see how good it is to join others who encounter Christ in a deeply personal way that has invigorated their faith. We are actively praying for our leadership team to help draw in and guide more people into this relationship with Jesus. We are also praying for more regular Alpha participants to pray about whether they are being called to leadership as well as the present team to discern their readiness, at some future time, to go deeper in their spirituality with offerings of "The Way" and "On Fire". For us to put into action what the DMI results will be sharing with us, we have to be spiritually motivated to do so. I believe combining deeper awareness of our spiritual need for growth with our community's need for unity and collaboration will propel us to succeed in building a dynamic, vibrant Church while we inspire missionary disciples to come forth from our midst.

I want to thank again Fr. Adrian Zikambona who visited us for our Mission Appeal last weekend and to thank all of you for your generosity and your welcoming of him. I also want to thank all of our parishioners who are receiving their Manifestation of the Kingdom and Papal awards at St. Paul Cathedral this Sunday afternoon for all of their devoted and loving service of the Church and of God's people. Congratulations to all of you! Finally, in a major way, my heartfelt thanks to Sr. Shannon Fox, who has graciously stepped up and has accepted the position of Interim Director of our Parish Pre-School and Nursery on the St. Malachy Campus. Your care and your heart are amazing and I believe our families feel the same!

She holds a Pennsylvania teaching license in Pre-K-12 special education; a bachelor's degree in psychology from Notre Dame College; and a master's degree in special education from Indiana University. She has been a religious sister for more than 20 years and recently moved to Pittsburgh from Illinois.

# A MESSAGE FROM THE DIOCESE OF PITTSBURGH: THE DISCIPLE MAKER INDEX SURVEY RESULTS ARE COMING

As you recall, the Disciple Maker Index Survey closed on March 31, 2023, and due to the great volume of information gathered, all of our parish leaders have been and continue to review the results. In next week's bulletin, you will see a one-page parish summary report that will provide information such as:



- How many parishioners completed the survey and the overall response rate
- Key parish strengths and opportunities for growth
- Summary of key responses

These results will enable parish Envisioning Teams, our pastoral planning leadership body, to begin the work of pastoral planning. The information will be repeated in the bulletin for the next two weeks to reach as many of our parishioners as possible during the summer travel season. In addition, stay tuned for a Diocesan summary report to be released the weekend of August 26/27, that will show a snapshot of the DMI Survey results for the entire Diocese of Pittsburgh.


