

### A MESSAGE FROM OUR CLERGY

### WILL YOU ANSWER HIS CALL?

Last week, a Gentile woman presented herself to Jesus, pleading for deliverance for her ill daughter. In turn, Jesus drew her closer by encouraging her to draw deeper into the well of her faith. By having the courage to do so, she felt the love of Christ and her daughter was healed. In the district of Tyre and Sidon, Christ found faith among those who were not expected to have it to show those of us who do have faith how much He is thirsting for a deeper faith in us. Today, He challenges the disciples to identify with Him as the One who will lead them to a greater ministry. The faith in Peter comes out boldly after Jesus asks them all who do they say He is. Our Lord is not looking for a bold proclamation as a sufficient expression of faith. Anyone can do that. What He is looking for is a deeper faith that comes alive in service, in ministry, and in verbal sharing with each other that expresses our joy in an intimate relationship with our Lord

Responding to Peter, Jesus establishes trust and responsibility in him to lead His Church. Christ is communicating the same desire to establish us as missionary disciples today. We heard our Alpha testimonies last weekend. Are you ready to accept His invitation to know the Lord in a deeper and more loving way? We are hearing Isabella Parrish speak to us about herself and the ministry she is charged with, caring for the formation of our youth and young adults. Are you willing to step up and help our younger generations find hope and community that is based in our Roman Catholic faith? Our parish ministries of liturgy, music, hospitality, community outreach, and more are nowhere near supplied enough by our parishioners, and the few who are doing their part are feeling the strain. Are you going to watch the parish become a poor representation of Christ through the few who are stepping up or are you going to answer the call of baptism in you to be an active contributor to the life of the faith? None of us can afford to sit and watch. Jesus wants you to get up and do His work today and tomorrow.

### **Disciple Maker Index Parish Results**

I would like to thank all who participated in the Disciple Maker Index earlier this year. In total, 51.6% of weekly mass attendees at Archangel Gabriel Parish completed the Survey.



The Disciple Maker Index provides our community with a deep analysis of attitudes and beliefs, participation, relationship/satisfaction, and demographics. At the same time, the DMI will assist us in assessing our greatest opportunities and strengths while developing a pastoral plan to move into the future by cultivating a deeper missionary spirit within the community.

Our Envisioning Team, composed of members of the parish, continues to study the data and use the results to help create a pastoral plan with specific goals and priorities for our parish community to focus on in the coming years. I am excited for where the Holy Spirit will lead Archangel Gabriel Parish.

### FOUR FACTORS OF A THRIVING PARISH

The DMI Survey collected responses on key areas of parish life that will allow us to continue to work toward becoming a more vibrant, thriving parish:

- Leadership Indicators 70% of respondents strongly agree/agree that they are provided opportunities to serve at the parish
- Sunday Experience 61% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the parish makes them feel welcome and accepted
- Spiritual Practices 68% of respondents state that they have personally encountered Jesus Christ and are growing as a disciple
- Missionary Impulse 92% of parents said that they strongly agree/agree that one of their most important responsibilities is helping their child to grow in faith

### STRENGTHS OF THE PARISH

The DMI Survey provided us information on what respondents saw as strengths of the parish:

- The Mass 61% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the parish offers vibrant and engaging liturgies
- Information Availability 89% of respondents strongly agree/agree that information via the bulletin, website, and social media is easy to find
- Preaching 58% of respondents strongly agree/agree that homilies connect their faith with everyday life
- Belief 91% of respondents strongly agree/agree that that the Eucharist is the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ

### **OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH**

The DMI Survey provided us areas of opportunity for growth:

- **Discipleship** 54% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the parish is helping to form them as a disciple of Jesus Christ
- Formation 45% of respondents strongly agree/agree that they feel confident that they could share the teachings of the Church with others
- Music 45% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the music offered at Mass deepens their desire to participate more fully in the Liturgy

### Disciple Maker Index Diocesan-Wide Results

During Lent of 2023, parishioners across the Diocese of Pittsburgh were invited to share their thoughts, reflect on their spiritual growth, and provide parish leadership with invaluable insight regarding their parish's strengths and opportunities through the Disciple Maker Index (DMI).



It is with a joyful heart that I share with you several high-level results of the Disciple Maker Index for the Diocese of Pittsburgh. These results take into account 24,133 surveys completed by members from each of our 61 parishes. It is clear that the parishes of the Diocese of Pittsburgh are truly moving forward through the grace of the Holy Spirit. The information provided in this survey is being utilized by each parish to create pastoral plans focused upon Evangelization, Discipleship, and Mission.

### FOUR FACTORS OF A THRIVING DIOCESAN PARISH

The DMI Survey collected responses on key areas of parish life that will allow us to continue to work toward becoming a more vibrant, thriving parish:

- Leadership Indicators 75% of respondents strongly agree/agree that they are provided opportunities to serve at the parish
- Sunday Experience 69% of respondents strongly agree/ agree that the parish offers vibrant and engaging liturgies
- Spiritual Practices 72% of respondents state that they have personally encountered Jesus Christ and are growing as a disciple and 76% of respondents state that they are growing in their faith and would like to grow more
- Missionary Impulse 96% of parents said that they strongly agree/agree that one of their most important responsibilities is helping their child to grow in faith

#### COLLECTIVE STRENGTHS OF ALL PARISHES IN THE DIOCESE

The DMI Survey provided us information on what respondents saw as strengths of the parish:

- **Belief** 91% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the Eucharist is the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ and 92% strongly agree/agree that scripture is the Word of God
- Community 77% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the parish makes them feel welcome and accepted
- Parish Life 83% of respondents strongly agree/agree that they would recommend their parish to others
- **Transparency** 74% of respondents strongly agree/agree that parish leadership is transparent regarding finances

#### OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH

The DMI Survey provided us areas of opportunity for growth:

- Discipleship 65% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the parish is helping to form them as a disciple of Jesus Christ
- Formation 55% of respondents strongly agree/agree that they feel confident that they can share the teachings of the Church with others
- **Liturgy** 62% of respondents strongly agree/agree that the music offered at Sunday Mass deepens their desire to participate more fully in the liturgy
- Evangelization 37% of respondents strongly agree/agree that they are comfortable sharing their personal witness story



### **HOLY PITTSBURGH TOUR**


