A MESSAGE FROM OUR CLERGY

THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

"We possess the prophetic message as something altogether reliable. Keep your attention closely fixed on it." Peter proclaims this instruction for our benefit, because we frequently question directions given, and we are easily distracted. We allow our weakness to get a hold on us, and we lose faith in the message. We doubt that the message is reliable, even believable, because we are surrounded by so many conflicting messages every day. Why do those other voices prevail?

When we read further in this second letter from Peter, we find that our attention should be as focused as "you would on a lamp shining in a dark place until the first streaks of dawn appear, and the morning star rises in your hearts." This tells us that we use our faculties to stay with an outside light in the midst of our darkness until, by an increasing expansion of our faith, we recognize a far better light showing itself from

within us – the light of Christ. This light guides our way with far more clarity than that of the world. If we are to be living in the world and, at the same time, not be of the world, we should rejoice in the feast day today as the time to choose an inward transformation.

What is shown in the Transfiguration of Christ is a sign of things to come, not just of His glory, but also of ourselves. The law of God in our hearts is shown in Moses. The living word is shown in Elijah. The words "do not be afraid" are spoken to help us resist weakness and instead embrace the strength of the Lord. We are entering into a time of challenge and change about how we regard our roles as missionary disciples for Christ. Our first tendency is to resist and to doubt the message because it requires us to change. That is our weakness shown in fear. As a faith-filled people, we are called to resist the fear, embrace the hope, and walk with Jesus as He leads us to transformation and abundant graces as the Next Generation Parish at Archangel Gabriel.

SECOND COLLECTION: MISSIONARY COOPERATIVE APPEAL AUGUST 5/6, 2023

Every year, the Diocese of Pittsburgh participates in the Missionary Cooperative Appeal. It's an opportunity for us to remember our calling to perform missionary work in conjunction with the Church. This year, on August 6, Fr. Adrian Zikambona will speak at Masses about the Sisters of Charity of St. Charles Borromeo in Tanzania. The second collection on August 5/6 will support the Sisters' ministries to people who are poor and marginalized, including:

- Orphanage centers to care for those orphaned by HIV/AIDS and other diseases.
- The education of orphans and adolescent girls from poor families whose parents might otherwise arrange a marriage to receive the bride price (a custom dowry of animals) from the groom and his family.
- The drilling of wells to provide local sources of clean water.
- Health care centers in villages that provide medication and pastoral care.

Thank you in advance for your generosity in both prayer and financial support for the people of Tanzania and in all mission territories throughout the world where the Church is present to offer spiritual and material assistance to God's people.

A MESSAGE FROM THE DIOCESE OF PITTSBURGH: A VISION FOR THE PARISH AND PASTORAL PRIORITIES

As many of you may know, Bishop Zubik is requiring that every parish in the diocese create a pastoral plan that will help us grow our mission and ministry over the next three to five years. All pastoral plans are due by February 14, 2024, but may be submitted as soon as this fall due to staggered pastoral planning schedules and the efforts and diligence of the Envisioning Team.

As our parish begins the work of pastoral planning, we will be charged to look to the future. In the next three to five years, how will our parish look and act differently? How will we be living out the purpose of the Church which was given to us by Christ: "Go into the whole world and proclaim the Good News to all of creation" (Mark 16:15)? The Envisioning Team, our pastoral planning leadership body, will work to create a parish vision that will answer these questions. The parish vision is a statement of hope that summarizes the way in which we will bring our mission to life. Accomplishing our parish vision for the future will not be a simple task. It will only be accomplished through much prayer, discernment, and work towards bringing about the mission of Christ.



As the work of pastoral planning continues, one of the key elements of our work will be developing three pastoral priorities. The priorities are specific to what the parish sees as needs of the community utilizing the results of the Disciple Maker Index Survey.

These pastoral priorities will move the vision forward for the next three to five years. The priorities are to be focused on accomplishing the vision for the future set by the Envisioning Team, while taking into account the three priorities that Bishop Zubik has identified for the diocese as the priority focus areas:

- Evangelization
- Missionary Discipleship
- Shifting the focus of the parishes from Maintenance to Mission

REMINDER: The universal distribution date for DMI results has been established for the weekend of August 19/20, 2023. All parishes in the diocese will use a common template to publish their individual results. Aggregate results for the entire diocese will be published in parish bulletins

PARISHIONERS TO RECEIVE HONORS AT DIOCESAN MANIFESTING THE KINGDOM AWARDS

All are invited to attend the Diocese of Pittsburgh Manifesting the Kingdom Awards, where two AGP parishioners will receive Papal Honors from Pope Francis and an additional seven parishioners will be honored with the Manifesting the Kingdom Award.

Rita Ferko Joyce, Esq., will receive the **Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice Papal Honor** for distinguished service to the Church by clergy and laypersons. It is the highest honor that can be awarded to the laity by the pope and is awarded based on the recommendation of the Diocesan Bishop, with final approval by the Vatican.

Rosemary Corsetti, Esq., will receive the **Benemerenti Medal,** which was instituted by the Holy See to bestow special recognition to persons who exhibited faithful service to their families and community, as well as exceptional service to the Church, no matter if they are lay or clergy, male or female, Catholic or non-Catholic. On the back of the medal is the word, "benemerenti, meaning "to a well-deserving person."
