FINDING FREEDOM IN FORGIVENESS

We celebrate Catechetical Sunday this weekend and all those who take part in teaching the faith. Understanding our faith opens the doors of the mind and the heart. Through that opening, the Holy Spirit conveys the message of truth and its meaning through prayer. These divine revelations open other doors, inspiring us to search further and to build confidence in sharing our faith experiences with each other. Courage now grows in us to ask questions and to seek answers.

What was going on in Peter as he asked Jesus how many times he should forgive his neighbor? Was it a guilty conscience? Was he wondering if someone else's answer was on the mark or not? Was he hoping he gave his neighbor enough chances already?

Can we see how these human perspectives fall short of the spiritual love our Lord wants us to give? If we don't set another person free from the burden of their sin, the feelings we hold onto make us captive as well. No one feels better. Both lose.

It takes a stronger person of faith to forgive their neighbor. Within there has to be an urge to heal and to be healed, to be closer to each other rather than to be separated by a fault. With love comes generosity; with freedom comes peace. Harmony and unity must be our goal. When we struggle with accepting this, another door opens, releasing our poorer self. The official in the gospel saw a closed relationship with the king upon hearing how his debt was to be repaid. That wasn't necessarily true as evidenced by the mercy the king gave when the official begged him for more time. The fault here is two-fold. The official didn't value the gift of mercy, because he didn't value the relationship with the king. Being closed in mind and heart, he abuses his freedom by threatening his fellow workers. Having shut himself off from other relationships, he incurs the wrath of the king.

We isolate ourselves when we choose not to forgive. With isolation comes misery, a lonely experience without others. Do we really want to risk that with our Lord?

We will celebrate our Archangels Triduum on Wednesday, September 27, through Friday, September 29, with the focus of the presentations on the Eucharist. Please do all that you can to pray and reflect with us at the parishes of Archangels Michael, Raphael, and Gabriel.
