


# Worship Aid

### A MESSAGE FROM OUR CLERGY

### WILL YOU ANSWER HIS CALL?

I am willing to bet that there is no prophet who has suffered more for God than Jeremiah. For all the abuse and rejection he received at the hands of his own people, he comes to the realization that the Lord pulled a fast one on him. A dresser of sycamore trees accepts the call to proclaim the message of God, and then he is told no one wants to hear those words. Jeremiah finds himself imprisoned, put in the stocks, and left in a well, sinking in the mud. God, if this is the way you treat your friends ...

This outcry, "you duped me Lord, and I let myself be duped", is actually a resignation that there is nothing he can do to avoid the will of God. You tricked me into taking this job; I didn't want it; I can't keep myself from doing it; and I feel I cannot endure the strain of it. I have no choice but to abandon myself to you and to accept being used by you as you see fit. As frustrating as this sounds, the experience of serving the Lord is a

part of spiritual renewal. I have to give up my wants and my sense of control, my vision and my plans, and so much more in order for me to come to peace with my God. It really feels like a contradiction, to empty myself so I may be filled with Him, but that is how we find our greatest joy. All that we want is limited, falls short of true satisfaction, is short-lived and not lasting.

What God put Jeremiah through was an example of love through sacrifice and of fulfillment through self-abandonment. It takes so much of our human strength away from us, this effort to become spiritually filled, that it feels like we are losing rather than gaining ground. Remember, we are limited for a reason and for a purpose, to rely on God and trust in His filling us with what we truly need. We hear from Paul how we are called to offer ourselves as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God. We are told not to conform ourselves to this age, but be transformed by the renewal of our mind so we can judge what is God's will, what is good, pleasing, and perfect. This is our spiritual journey, and it includes the renewal of our heart and prayer for the sake of the one Body of Christ to which we all belong and the one parish which we call our spiritual home.

Let us welcome with joy our parish families, especially our youngest members, as we begin Children's Liturgy of the Word within the 10:00 AM Mass at Holy Trinity Church next weekend!



# Second Collection September 9 & 10 Bishop's Education Fund


