Q & A WITH THE CLERGY

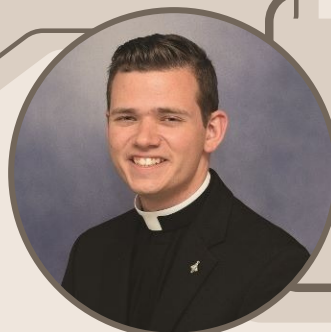
If I forget to say a sin in the confessional will God still forgive me?

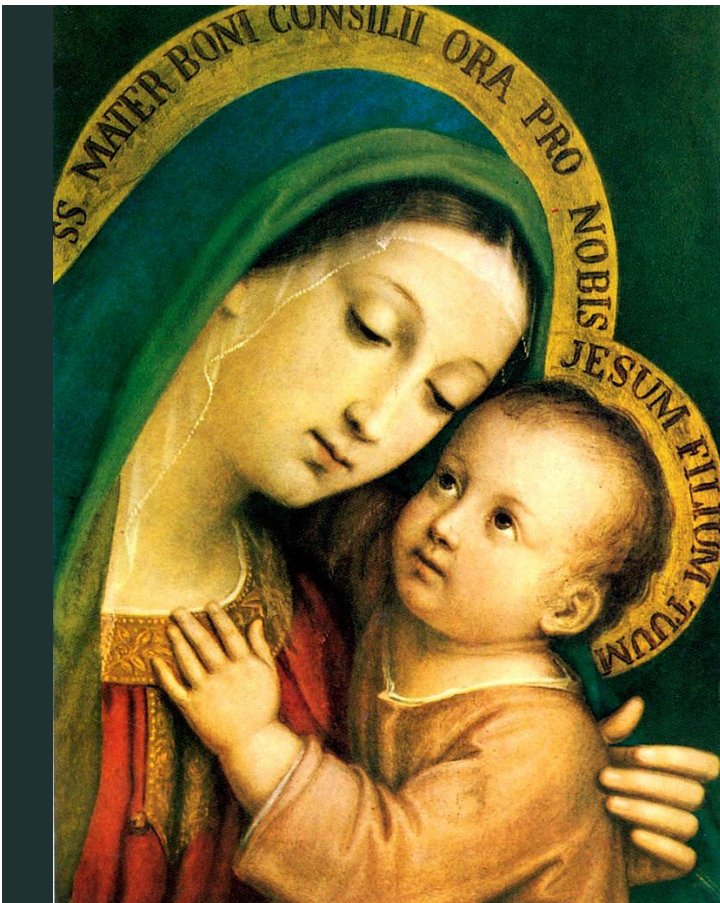

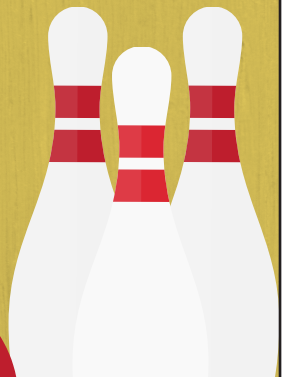
