### **MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY**

Our beloved Pastor, Fr. Ken, is away this week and asked that I provide a short bulletin reflection. Please pray for him as he seeks to get some well deserved rest and recreation.

With the first Sunday of Advent, we began reading Cycle -C from our Sunday Lectionary. In this cycle, we primarily, but not exclusively, read the "order" of Christ's life and ministry (hence the use of the phrase "Ordinary Time"). This year we will read Luke's Gospel.

However, the beginning of 2025 provides us with a small set of readings that come to us from the early Church and her three-fold cycle for the Feast of the Epiphany. That ancient Lectionary saw a connection between three of the many Epiphanies of the Lord, and the Church read them liturgically. The first was the arrival of the Magi, then the Baptism of the Lord, and finally the Wedding Feast of Cana.

Fortunately the Fathers at the Second Vatican Council were made aware of this echo from early Christianity, and in the restoration of the three-fold cycles, returned this sequence in our "new" Cycle - C. Therefore, this year, we will have the three Sunday Gospels, as did the ancient Church. Last week, we read of the Manifestation of the Christ to the Nations (Magi); this week, the Baptism by John (first manifestation of the Trinity); and on the 2nd Sunday of Ordinary Time for Cycle -C, the Wedding Feast of Cana (the First sign/manifestation of Jesus' Divinity in John's Gospel).

While there are many "epiphanies" in the gospels, such as Jesus walking on water, the raising of Lazarus, the Transfiguration on the holy mountain, etc. Each of these three represents a beginning (birth of the New Born King, initiation of Jesus sacred ministrys and the first of many miracles). They each serve as an "Introduction" to the "Order" of Christ's life and ministry. As we follow Him, let us ask for the graces we need to be faithful companions along the Way (HODOS), the first name for Christianity.

As well, let us continue to rejoice in the many gifts our God has bestowed on us as individuals and families, but also as a community of worship and faith. Let us all be attentive to the readings at our Masses, where we break open the Word of God in preparation to break open the Bread of Life! Such great gifts! Not things, but Him who came to give us life, indeed the life of the Only-begotten Son of God!

## **Anointing Mass**

Sunday, February 16 | 12:30 PM Holy Trinity Church

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after anointing but becomes ill once again, or if, during the same illness, the person's condition becomes more serious. A person should be anointed before surgery or when a dangerous illness is the reason for the intervention. Moreover, older people may be anointed if they are in a weak condition, even though no dangerous illness is present. Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be comforted by this Sacrament.

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be in God's will, the person will be healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age. The Anointing of the Sick is one of two sacraments of healing, the other being the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

All those who wish to be anointed should check in prior to the start of Mass at the registration table in the Narthex. You will be directed where to sit, and the priests will come to you for the Sacrament.
