#### **MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY**

**THE BIRTHDAY OF ARCHANGEL GABRIEL PARISH:** Did you know that our parish was founded on January 6, 2020? If we were celebrating a wedding, it would be known as our wood anniversary, with wood symbolizing the strength and stability a couple has built in their first five years of marriage. Like a tree that withstands storms, their relationship has weathered challenges and grown stronger. I think this also applies to the parish! You have weathered challenges, and clergy changes, and have grown stronger as a unified community. This is something to be proud of and to celebrate.

This brought to my mind the religious theme of the wood of the cross. Jesus chose to transform the wood of the cross into the new tree of life. From His cross comes our salvation. He has been lifted up for the entire world to see. This was prefigured in the Old Testament (Numbers 21:4-9), when Moses erected a bronze serpent on a pole so that anyone who had been bitten by a snake could look at it and be healed. We all could use some healing in our lives these days, and the Church offers us the opportunity to look upon the Lord to find our own healing. As Catholics we "look upon the Lord" through Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Pope Pius XII, in his encyclical *Mediator Dei*, spoke of how Adoration

has contributed to a deeper understanding of Christ's presence outside of Mass. He pointed out that the different forms of Eucharistic Adoration "have brought a wonderful increase in faith and supernatural life to the Church upon earth." Adoration, in all its forms, is an extension of the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament that occurs in every Mass: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb." Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament flows from the sacrifice of the Mass and serves to deepen our hunger for Communion with Christ and His Church.

**ADORATION:** Here at Archangel Gabriel Parish, we are blessed to have serval ways to adore the Lord outside of Mass. I would like to invite you consider making Adoration a part of your prayer life in 2025. Pope Francis called for a return to such devotion in *Dilexit nos*, stating, "While no one should feel obliged to spend an hour in Adoration, the practice ought surely to be recommended." A weekly hour of Adoration also responds directly to the call of the Eucharistic Revival we are currently undergoing. I invite you to discern what is possible for you and your family as it concerns praying via Adoration of the Lord.

Here are the ways you can adore the Lord at Archangel Gabreil Parish:

- **Stop Into Holy Trinity Church for a Visit:** Adoration of Our Lord via a visit to a church is, and remains, the normal and most common mode of adoration for Catholics worldwide. This happens by visiting a church to pray before the Lord reposed in the tabernacle. This method mimics the faith of the blind men of Scripture, who although they could not see the Lord, believed and called out to him in faith and hope. For our parish, Holy Trinity Church is open seven days a week for such visits.
- Extended Adoration: To help our faithful meditate on and adore the profound mystery of the True
  Presence of Christ, we offer two sessions of extended Adoration one in the morning, following daily
  Mass at both Saint Mary and Saint Malachy Churches, concluding at 12:00 PM; and a second following the
  evening Mass at Holy Trinity Church on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, ending at 10:00 PM.
- **Family Adoration:** On the first Friday of the month, we offer family-friendly Adoration at Holy Trinity Church from 1:30 4:00 PM. This time is designed to be a welcoming experience, allowing "children to be children" in the presence of our Lord. It's an opportunity to introduce your children to Adoration in an environment where they are free to move around, ask questions, and not worry about disturbing others. You do not need to stay for an hour; you are invited to come and stay as long as your family is able.
- Thursday Evening Holy Hour: Beginning January 9, we are launching a parish Holy Hour on Thursdays at 7:30 PM at Saint Malachy Church. Unlike the other opportunities to adore the Lord, which are private, our parish Holy Hour will be a communal celebration of Adoration. This Holy Hour will foster our sense of community as we support one another in the spiritual journey we undertake as members of the Body of Christ. The communal aspect of worship enhances the experience of Adoration, as it reflects the Church's mission to be a united community of believers. These Holy Hours will be thematic and focused on praying for a specific need of our Church or community.
- **Confession and Adoration:** I also remind you that each Saturday, at Saint Malachy Church, confessions are heard from 11:00 AM 12:00 PM with Adoration. This period of Adoration ends with Benediction.



Rehearsal for candidates AND their sponsors will be held on May 7 at 7:00 PM in Saint Malachy Church.



If you do not attend one of the sessions, you will not be able to distribute Holy Communion at Mass or take the Blessed Sacrament to the sick or homebound.




## Consolation Ministry



## **Anointing Mass**

## Sunday, February 16 | 12:30 PM Holy Trinity Church

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after anointing but becomes ill once again, or if, during the same illness, the person's condition becomes more serious. A person should be anointed before surgery or when a dangerous illness is the reason for the intervention. Moreover, older people may be anointed if they are in a weak condition, even though no dangerous illness is present. Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be comforted by this Sacrament.

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be in God's will, the person will be healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age. The Anointing of the Sick is one of two sacraments of healing, the other being the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

All those who wish to be anointed should check in prior to the start of Mass at the registration table in the Narthex. You will be directed where to sit, and the priests will come to you for the Sacrament.
