MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK: On

February 11, the Church observes the World Day of the Sick, an opportunity to recognize the sick and those who care for them. The date coincides with the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, when Mary appeared to St. Bernadette, and honors the many pilgrims who have experienced healing at the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes.

Our Catholic teaching views suffering as a profound mystery. Pope Francis calls our attention to the truth that God remains close to those who

suffer, and they have an important role to play in our faith. By uniting our suffering with Christ's, we can participate in the story of redemption and contribute to the sacrifice of the Church. Suffering, for the faithful, is a path to personal growth, fostering virtues, and drawing us closer to God. It also has communal implications, calling all to take part in the suffering of others via direct care, prayers, empathy, compassion, or other forms of support. Ultimately, we look to the Paschal Mystery of Christ, which offers hope, showing that suffering, though difficult, can lead to redemption and eternal life. We are called to offer our suffering to Christ's Paschal Mystery, as Saint Paul indicated when he stated, "Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I am filling up what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ on behalf of his body, which is the church" (Col 1:24).

I encourage you read the Pope's message for the World Day of the Sick. Copies are available at the Church entrance or online: https://www.vatican.va/content/francesco/en/messages/sick/documents/20250114-giornata-malato.html.

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is fundamentally a liturgical, and thus a communal, celebration. An anointing Mass emphasizes the Church's role in supporting one another during times of illness and suffering. I encourage you to experience this beautiful liturgy and offer your prayerful support of those who are suffering.

NATIONAL MARRIAGE WEEK (FEB 7-14) AND WORLD

MARRIAGE DAY (FEB 9): Each year, National Marriage Week and World Marriage Day provide an opportunity for us to focus on the importance of family life and celebrate the vocation of marriage. It is an opportunity for married couples to reflect on how they have grown together since their wedding day and to ponder how they can continue to grow in loving and honoring their spouse as partners for life. 

World Marriage Day Blessing of Married Couples February 9, 2025

Each year, World Marriage Day provides an opportunity for the Catholic Church to focus on and celebrate the vocation to marriage and family life. In celebration of this occasion, during all Masses this weekend, married couples will have the opportunity to receive a blessing at all AGP Masses.



Anointing Mass

Sunday, February 16 | 12:30 PM Holy Trinity Church

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after anointing but becomes ill once again, or if, during the same illness, the person's condition becomes more serious. A person should be anointed before surgery or when a dangerous illness is the reason for the intervention. Moreover, older people may be anointed if they are in a weak condition, even though no dangerous illness is present. Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be comforted by this Sacrament.

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be in God's will, the person will be healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age. The Anointing of the Sick is one of two sacraments of healing, the other being the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

All those who wish to be anointed should check in prior to the start of Mass at the registration table in the Narthex. You will be directed where to sit, and the priests will come to you for the Sacrament.






