

MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

AN HOUR OF GRACE LENTEN CHALLENGE

In leading up to Lent, we heard the Lord ask a hard question: Why don't you perceive the wooden beam in your eyes? It is difficult for us to be self-reflective, especially when we don't even know our truest identity. What is our truest identity? We are the beloved of God, we are the body of Christ. Therefore, to see clearly, to even notice the beam in our own eye, we must see with the eyes of Christ. However, to see with his eyes means we must know Christ more intimately, more deeply, more authentically, more lovingly. We are Christians, and everything in our lives is only perceived clearly through Christ.

Lent is the special time of the Liturgical Year during which we challenge ourselves in prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Why? So, we can grow closer to Christ and see the world as he sees it. The closer we come to Christ, the more clearly we see ourselves. For that reason, as a clergy team, we are issuing a challenge to come one hour closer to Christ each week during Lent - a challenge we are calling "An Hour of Grace".

That can mean coming to meet Christ in his home, bringing him into our own homes, or finding him in our community. A pilgrimage to the Church, where the Lord is always Eucharistically present, brings us face-to-face with the true presence of Christ; inviting him into our homes allows us to encounter the Lord in the familiarity of our lives, where he longs to find us; and meeting him with our brothers and sisters in the community allows us to see that faith is not lived out in isolation but in relationship with others. It is encountering Christ which allows us to learn who he is and see who we are as members of his Body.

Join us this Lent in adding an Hour of Grace every week, removing our beams, and letting Christ teach us, once and for all, to see clearly.

Use the parish FORMED online video, audio, and ebook library or the parish Franciscan at Home subscription. Both can be accessed via the Parish website under the "Grow" tab. Use the Hallow App, a popular devotional app, with optional subscription. 		
One Hour of Grace within the Communal Church	 Attend or volunteer at the Fish Fry. Take a Tia Chi class with Deacon Tim. Attend a Young Adult, EDGE, or Life Teen event. Join one of our many organizations. See the "Get Involved" tab on the website for more details. Participate in one of our parish events, like the blood drive, movie night, or Women's Day Out. 

This page represents the financial statement for Archangel Gabriel Parish for the fiscal six-month period ended December 31, 2024. This financial statement is presented in a standard format that all parishes within the Diocese of Pittsburgh utilize.

During this time period, we launched a new offertory envelope program, which has improved service, reduced waste, saved on overall cost, and fully integrated all collections, providing more secure control of financial information. In direct correlation with the completion of the the parish census, we were able to properly align our database that is used to control parishioner mailings which resulted in a significant cost savings.
