MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

In last week's bulletin I asked what your plans for Holy Week were. I hope you took that question seriously. Now that Holy Week is upon us, are you ready? This is a great opportunity to give yourself a personal retreat week. Remember, in our Catholic faith, we consider a retreat to be a period of secluded prayer and reflection aimed at drawing us closer to God and better understanding His will. By withdrawing from daily life, we provide ourselves with the opportunity to focus on spiritual growth through prayer, meditation, and contemplation. This offers each of us the benefits of improved mental and spiritual health, a strengthened will, increased ability to align our actions with the virtue of reason and not the impulse of desire, all accomplished within silence and reflection. Ultimately, a retreat is an inward journey using silence, prayer, and the deep pondering of the life of Christ to discern His will for us and undergo the personal and spiritual transformation necessary to achieve freedom, peace, and joy.

Holy Week is a unique time of the year to accomplish a personal, self-directed retreat. Now is the moment to decide to make this week different. How will you add more silence? It would be a great week to impose a technology fast – perhaps you and your family could turn off all electronics three hours before bedtime to talk with one another or read a GOOD book. Perhaps this is the week you spend an extra hour in prayer at one of the Churches. This may be the week that you return to the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Many today ask, "why do I need to go to confession?" and I say why would you not want to receive all the graces and help the Lord has to offer? The Sacrament of Reconciliation is more powerful than I can cover here, but I would point out that it builds our humility and honesty, fostering these virtues which are foundational to living a healthy life. In Confession, we confront our weaknesses and take responsibility for our actions so that we can take steps to improve ourselves. Yes, those steps might be small, and we might take one step forward and two steps back at times, but it will be a journey with the Lord and He will walk that path with us.

If you have the chance to join in all liturgies, including the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the Liturgy of the Passion of the Lord, and the Easter Vigil, I promise it will be a very moving experience. You can kick off the last days of Easter preparation with attending the Living Stations of the Cross at Saint Mary's Church so that you have a fresh understanding of Christ's way to Calvary and the tomb. If your heart is moved more towards public displays of love and support for your neighbors, then join in the Ecumenical Cross Walk on Friday. Bring a cross that you can carry as we walk the streets of McKees Rocks as public witnesses of our faith, hope, and love in Jesus Christ.

There are so many opportunities this week to make a private retreat. How will you withdraw from your daily life, even if just one hour a day? How will you pray differently this week (Mass, Rosary, Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Lectio Divina, Adoration, or a Holy Hour)? What will you allow yourself to meditate on? With proper preparation, it will be possible to experience the great mystery of our faith immersed by the Holy Spirit in contemplation of the Empty Tomb and the victory over sin and death.

Tenebrae Service Good Friday | April 18 8:30 PM | Holy Trinity Church

The word "tenebrae" means "shadows" or "darkness" in Latin, and it comes from the Scripture passage that says, "darkness (tenebrae) came over the whole land" (Matthew 27:45) at Christ's death. The origins of the Tenebrae service go back at least to the 5th century, when churches were already gathering for services in the deep darkness of the night, gradually extinguishing candles and chanting Psalms and Lamentations.

There are quite a few different ways that parishes have done Tenebrae services, both in times past and nowadays. At our service this year, you can expect to pray the full Office of Readings from Good Friday's Liturgy of the Hours, with exquisite singing, dramatic readings, and an immersive visual and audible experience. No prior experience with Liturgy of the Hours is necessary, and you can easily follow along with the program. With help from Franciscan University singers and our parish's own talented choir, this service should be a beautiful, even if unfamiliar, experience for all who come.
