

#### MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

Alleluia! Christ is risen! On this glorious Easter day, our hearts overflow with joy and gratitude as we celebrate the cornerstone of our faith – the resurrection of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

The empty tomb speaks volumes. It is a testament to the power of God's love, a love that conquers even death itself. Today we celebrate with great joy the renewal of our Faith, Hope, and Love, which were strengthened as we traveled Christ's paschal mystery through our Lenten journey into his death and into the manifestation of eternal life.

Easter is not simply an historical event; it is a living reality that needs to transform our lives. It calls us to live with hope in the face of despair, to extend forgiveness as we have been forgiven, and to share the good news of God's love with all we encounter. As such, let us consider how we treat those who are experiencing hardship or loneliness, the outcasts, and the sick. Let us be what Christ is to us

and act with compassion and kindness, embodying the love that Christ freely gives to us.

Remember as well that Easter Sunday is more than one day; it as an octave. The octave serves to deepen our experience of the mysteries won for us. The Easter Octave provides opportunities for great rejoicing as we extend our purposeful meditation on Christ's resurrection, the triumph over evil and death, and the gift of eternal life extended to all by the Lord. The Easter Octave, and thus Easter itself, concludes on the eighth day, known as Divine Mercy Sunday. In my opinion, there is no greater way to honor the Lord's passion, death, and resurrection than to highlight the fullness of the gift won for us: Divine Mercy itself.

As you proceed throughout this week, I encourage you to raise up your voice with many Alleluias! For He has risen, we are an Easter people and Alleluia is our song. However, I also encourage you to mediate deeply upon the actions this reality of true love calls us to implement in our lives. He has won mercy, forgiveness, and redemption for us. He has won these for you and me and all who respond to Him with a humble and

contrite heart. Now, we must share this with others so all may come to know this great gift of Love.

The Image of Divine Mercy, based on a vision of Jesus that St. Faustina experienced, is one way our faith draws us closer to God's mercy, while encouraging us to extend that mercy to others. In her vision, Jesus appeared with rays of red and pale light emanating from His heart. These rays symbolize the blood and water that flowed from Jesus' heart, representing the Sacraments and the mercy of God. The Lord Jesus requested that this image be painted and displayed to the world, with the inscription "Jesus, I trust in You." The purpose of the devotion of Divine Mercy is to serve as a reminder of the value of every human being and the need for compassion, especially towards those who are suffering. Divine Mercy Sunday, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, and the veneration of the Divine Mercy image encourage all of us (most especially the ones who feel least worthy of God's love) to turn to God with trust and to seek and find His mercy. It also reminds those of us already living in the Faith, Hope, and Charity of Christ to be merciful to others in our thoughts, words, actions, and prayers. Happy Easter!







# **Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion NEEDED**

At the end of every Mass, the priest or deacon charges us to "Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life!" In other words, take what you have received here out into the world and share it with others. 

#### For our Unbaptized:

At the Easter Vigil Mass, Archangel Gabriel Parish will joyfully welcome Annie Baich, Bruce Feagins, and Elana Lieberman into the Catholic Church through the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion.

Through the OCIA Ministry, Annie, Bruce, and Elana have moved through the Period of Inquiry (when they were titled "Inquirer"), celebrated the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens, and moved through the Period of the Catechumenate (when they were titled "Catechumen"), celebrated the Rite of Election, and moved through the Period of Purification & Enlightenment (when they were titled "Elect"). They now enter the Period of Mystagogy with the new title of Neophyte. Please keep our beloved Neophytes in your prayers as they begin their new lives in Christ!

Christian Initiation is offered on a year-round basis for those who:

- Are not baptized (Catechumen)
- Were baptized in a Protestant denomination or baptized Catholic and never received catechesis (Uncatechized Candidate)
- Were baptized in a Protestant denomination and have received catechesis (Candidate)
- Are a cathechized Catholic who never received the sacrament of Confirmation (Confirmation Candidate)
- Are fully initiated in the Eastern Rite seeking to make a profession of faith in the Latin Rite


#### MAGNIFICAT PRAYER BREAKFAST FOR WOMEN




# COME & SEE OPEN HOUSE AT ST. PAUL CATHEDRAL PARISH
