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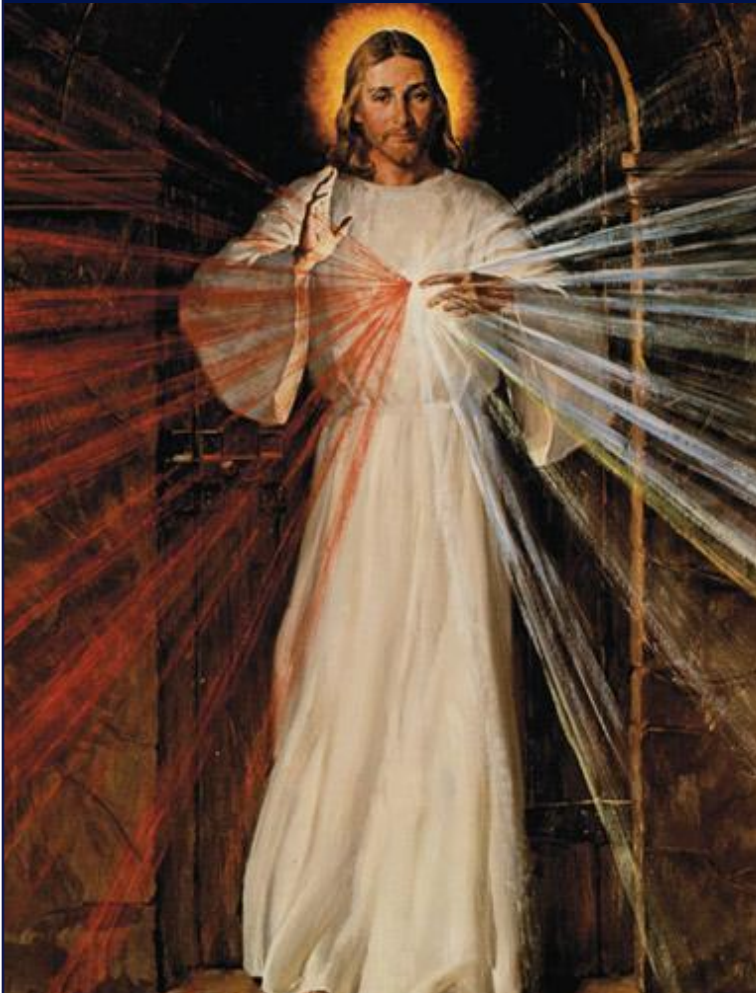

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MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

This week is full of wonderful things, including the octave day of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday) and the Reception into Full Communion of Jack, Zachary, Sheri, Tracy, Jeff, Ira, Brett, Braehm, and Nicole. Annie, Bruce, and Elana will join us from the start of the Mass as fully initiated Catholics. This weekend, we will celebrate First Holy Communions at two of our Masses and six baptisms. Then on May 1, we will celebrate a Mass in honor of Saint Joseph, the Patron Saint of the Universal Church, families, fathers, and workers. We will also celebrate the beginning of May, a month we dedicate to the Blessed Mother. Each of these truly deserves a full page of attention. However, with the passing of Pope Francis, we find ourselves in a position that may bring forth fear, confusion, and rumors that lead to spiritual anxiety. I am sure many of us are wondering what does this all mean for the Church and for me.

Be not afraid! Rest assured, the Church's one foundation is Christ, the Risen Lord!

For now, we are called to mourn and remember Pope Francis with our prayers but also, hopefully, with our lives! On Monday, a Flocknote was sent out offering ideas on how to pray for the repose of the soul of Pope Francis. I've included a portion of that message below to help you explore how you can honor the profound impact of Pope Francis' ministry of love.

- Parishioners are asked to pray the *Our Father*, *Hail Mary*, and *Glory Be*, or recite the Rosary for the Pope.
- All are encouraged to offer Corporal or Spiritual Works of Mercy for the intention of Pope Francis's soul.
- **Corporal Works of Mercy:** feed the hungry (e.g., make a donation to a food bank); give drink to the thirsty (e.g., make a donation to food pantry); clothe the naked (e.g., drop off clothing to the Saint Vincent de Paul bins); shelter the homeless (e.g., donate to a homeless shelter); visit the sick; visit the imprisoned (e.g., visit those who are unable to leave their homes); and bury the dead (e.g., visit the cemetery and pray for your deceased loved ones).
- **Spiritual Works of Mercy:** admonish the sinner (give correction to those who need it); instruct the ignorant (share our knowledge with others); counsel the doubtful (give advice to those who need it); comfort the sorrowful; bear wrongs patiently; forgive all injuries; pray for the living and the dead.

These customary nine days of mourning following the death of a Pope is our time to remember and to pray. Personally, I experienced the pontificate of Pope Francis as a culmination of the knowledge of the Faith given to me by Saint John Paul II and the hope provided to me by Pope Benedict XVI. Pope Francis manifested, for me, the true Charity of Christ, as he witnessed to the world how all Christians must exercise constant care, concern, and outreach to the poor, the sick, the oppressed, our neighbor, and even creation itself.

As the Church's official days of mourning end, and once the Pope's funeral has been celebrated, we will prepare for the election of a new Pontiff. For now, let us offer words and deeds as prayers of thanksgiving for Francis, who now is experiencing the fruit of Easter's Resurrection and Jesus' Divine Mercy!

We give thanks to the Father for the pontificate of Pope Francis and ask God to welcome this blessed servant into his merciful and loving embrace. We ask Jesus to choose a worthy successor to Peter, the Apostle whom he chose to lead his Church. And we ask the Holy Spirit to guide the Church again and still.
