## WHAT ARE YOUR PLANS FOR HOLY WEEK?

As we approach the end of Lent, it is time to begin to plan for the holiest week of the year. What are you planning to do differently during Holy Week? This week offers so many opportunities for you to step out of the ordinary and prepare yourself for Easter. Perhaps you will stop in for Adoration, attend the living stations of the cross, join us for the Mass of the Lord's Supper, join the Cross Walk, attend the Passion of the

Lord liturgy, or simply stop in the Church to spend time with the Lord. Whatever you do, do something special. Make Holy Week different! You are invited to everything, and I hope you come and pray with us. See you in Church.

#### TENEBRAE INVITATION FROM FR. JACOB GRUBER

You may have seen among the advertisements for the various liturgies coming up in Holy Week that this Good Friday, we will have a Tenebrae liturgy at 8:30 PM at Holy Trinity Church. In addition to whatever other Holy Triduum services you can make it to, I want to extend an invitation and a plea for you to come to this Tenebrae service on Good Friday if you can. In short, it's going to be awesome.

The word "tenebrae" means "shadows" or "darkness" in Latin, and it comes from the Scripture passage that says, "darkness (tenebrae) came over the whole land" (Matthew 27:45) at Christ's death. The origins of the Tenebrae service go back at least to the 5th century, when churches were already gathering for services in the deep darkness of the night, gradually extinguishing candles and chanting Psalms and Lamentations.

There are quite a few different ways that parishes have done Tenebrae services, both in times past and nowadays. At our service this year, you can expect to pray the full Office of Readings from Good Friday's Liturgy of the Hours, with exquisite singing, dramatic readings, and an immersive visual and audible experience. No prior experience with Liturgy of the Hours is necessary, and you can easily follow along with the program. With help from Franciscan University singers and our parish's own talented choir, this service should be a beautiful, even if unfamiliar, experience for all who come. Check it out, and let us know how you liked it!


## AGP RESPECT LIFE PARTICIPATES IN 40 DAYS FOR LIFE

#### **40 DAYS FOR LIFE CLOSING EVENT**


