MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

Mother's Day: Happy Mother's Day to all our mothers, grandmothers and godmothers. Motherhood is a beautiful gift of God to all. It is a true calling, a vocation to nurture, love, and educate children in the faith and Christian values. Mothers are role models of sacrifice, dedication, service, and unwavering love. A mother's example is the beginning of the teaching of our faith and the manifestation of God's presence in our lives. So, to all mothers, we say thank you and wish you a wonderful Mother's Day.

Pentecost Lunch: Often called the Birthday of the Church, Pentecost is the time when the Holy Spirit empowered the disciples to be bold and fearless in going out to proclaim the Gospel message. It is a time to rejoice in what we accomplish as a parish Church and the clergy team wishes to celebrate you. On Pentecost (June 8) the clergy will host a lunch for our parishioners. It is a time for us to acknowledge you and how you proclaim the Gospel in the world today. The lunch will be in Weirauch Hall and will be served from 11:30 AM - 3:30 PM. Mark your calendar now and look for more information in upcoming bulletins.

First Holy Communions: What a joy it has been to celebrate First Holy Communions. Congratulations to all who received our Lord for the first time, and to each family who was able to experience that joy. The Church itself was full of excitement and rightfully so. To receive Jesus in the Eucharist is truly to receive food for our journey; this food however, is the strength of God himself. May we all remember that the Lord is waiting for us to come to him. May we all approach Communion with the same excitement and love that our First Holy Communicants have shown us.

Vestments: Many of you may have noticed the new vestments that appeared on Laetare Sunday (rose), Palm Sunday (red), and Easter (white). These vestments are part of a gift given to the parish to mark the arrival of the new clergy team. Back in July, three families donated matching sets of vestments for each of our churches. Although they do not wish to receive public recognition, I do want to say thank you to them (you know who you are). Your generosity has added to the beauty of our liturgy, which helps all to lift our hearts and minds to the Lord.

Saint Mary, Help of Christian Feast Day: May 24 is the feast day of Mary under the title of Help of Christians. That weekend is the 6th Sunday of Easter, which ranks above a feast day, so we cannot fully celebrate at either the 6:00 PM or 11:00 AM Mass. However, we will have special music at both Masses in honor of Mary, and we will transfer the feast celebration to Monday, May 26 at the 9:30 AM Mass. It will be a special celebration to entrust the military personnel who sacrificed all for our freedom to the protection of our Blessed Mother.

Saint Mary Campus: There are many projects that are being addressed at Saint Mary, Help of Christians Campus. In a perfect world, we would have all the resources necessary to restore the campus to its former glory. However, the reality is that we must deal with the most pressing issues first. For now, we are in the process of doing repairs to the water backflow system, which is necessary if we are to continue to have water to the Church, rectory, and the Gathering Place. I will soon be providing an updated plan for the Rose window and the scaffolding in the front of the Church. Please know that we are taking steps to ensure that the campus is safe, functional, and beautiful.

Parish Councils: Having put out a call for people to discern membership on the parish finance and pastoral councils, our next step in the process is to hold an informational meeting with those who expressed an interest. This meeting will provide detailed information on what being a council member entails. After this meeting, there will be an additional period for personal discernment to determine if the individual is interested and able to make the commitment that is expected and required to be on the council. Following that discernment, there will be final interviews and the selection of members.

Saint Malachy Campus: With the closing of Archangel Gabriel Preschool and Nursery there is now unused space on the Saint Malachy Campus. A committee to evaluate the best use of this space will be considering our parish's needs and resources to determine how to use this space. As for a timeline, I hope to make decisions by June. so that we can transition the space during July with the goal of having the space open by late August. I'll keep you posted.






