MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

The Growing Church: The other day, after Mass, someone complimented me on the number of people who are joining the Church. It can seem very impressive. We have three catechumens, now neophytes, who entered at the Vigil Mass, and we have one more who will join in a special Mass coming up. We had nine candidates received into full communion on Divine Mercy Sunday. There were two parishioners who entered the Church alongside their peers at Archangel Gabriel School's Mass this past week within Holy Trinity Church. There will be five adults receiving Confirmation this week with 67 of our young men and women. Not counting those who are receiving Confirmation "on schedule" (or the six wonderful children I baptized this past Sunday), one might say we added twenty people into full communion of the Church in two weeks. That is a good number. But I do not deserve the credit or the praise. Our Church, our parish, grows because of you! You come to the church, to Mass, to the Sacraments to be fed by the clergy. We are ordained to provide you with the nourishment you need: spiritual, intellectual, inspirational, practical, and sacramental. Once we feed you, we send you forth

into the world, refreshed and able to be the Light of Christ for others. If we do our mission properly, you will inspire a sense of wonder and awe in those you meet in your daily lives. Your witness will then attract others to our Fatih. Your peaceful way of life will make them want to take part in the joy of the Gospel. It is by your witness that the stranger feels comfortable coming to this House of the Lord to hear about his love for them, learn of his Divine Mercy, receive his forgiveness, and accept the invitation to join his family. When you "Go in Peace," glorifying the Lord by your life, when you go and announce the Gospel of the Lord, you are the ones who draw people to the Church. You are fulling your baptismal mission. You are fulfilling the mission of Archangel Gabriel Parish by being missionary disciples for Jesus Christ and his Church. For that reason, you are also the ones who deserve all the credit for the growth of the Church. Please continue to pray for our clergy, that we may inspire all of you so that you may shine brightly as the light of Christ. Make him known to our neighbors and in our neighborhood.

Confirmation: The Confirmation of our 67 candidates this week is a very special grace to them and our parish. This unique outpouring of the Holy Spirit comes at a time when our young men and women need to face difficult life decisions and make plans to become active disciples of our Lord. Taking a pivotal step forward towards adulthood, Confirmation strengthens them with the gifts of the Holy Spriit needed to be courageous in following Christ. In Baptism, they began their new lives within the Church; with the Eucharist, they were fed the Bread of Life to nourish them through their pre-adolescent years; and now, taking the next step, they are strengthened again by a sacrament. Being asked to face the world, often on their own, they are now fully initiated into the Church, having full rights and responsibilities of being Christ to others. They enter this new mission filled with the Holy Spirit. Let us make sure they also enter it fully backed by our prayers and our support. Let all people know we walk together in our Fatih!

Latest Health Update: First, allow me to express my deep appreciation for the prayers you have offered for me. It is greatly appreciated. I know that the Lord is receiving them and applying their grace where it is needed the most. The Lord is wonderful and I trust in his plan. With that said, I need to tell you that my infusion treatments did not produce the expected outcome. I have had to restart the previous medications and receive some blood. My doctor ordered additional tests to check on other possible issues as well. Meanwhile, I will be experimenting with medication in the coming weeks to see what impact it has on my health to determine the next step. For my part, I am going to take some time off, at least ten days, to rest. I know that it is better for me to be healthy and attentive to my duties than to continue to wear myself down. While I'm off resting, I know that you will continue to be the presence of Christ to one another - and that is why you are such a great Church!






