Respecting Life in October: We know that October is Respect Life Month in the Catholic Church. It's a time for reflection on the dignity of every human life and for building a culture that cherishes and protects life from conception to natural death. As a parish we do so much to live out the call to respect all life. During October we have seen (or will see) specific ways we focus our care for others, such as the Rosary for Life, Blessing of Expectant Mothers, Baby Bottle Collection, Feed the Needy Food Drive, Winter Coat and Clothing Drive, the Ladies of Charity Blood Drive, 40 Days for Life, and the Service of Love Prayer Blanket Ministry, in addition to all the prayers we offer both privately and publicly. Leading up to October, our parish participated in the PA March for Life at the State Capital on September 22. As we enter November, we will witness our love and care for those who have passed away (a special thank you to our Consolation and Bereavement Ministries). We are a parish that respects life and one that offers many opportunities throughout the year for you to become actively involved in showing your love and respect.

All actions we take to respect life are important. Some are far more visible than others. One way we respect life is through prayer. However, prayer is not visible like baby bottles or coat collections. It is heartwarming and encouraging to see the generosity of our parish. When I issued a prayer challenge to the parish for October, one of the thoughts I had in mind was to provide a visualization of the prayers we offer on behalf of others. That prayer challenge, to pray for peace in our nation, our communities, and our parish, was brought about by the many tragic events that have swept across our nation recently. This past weekend, I preached on the importance of offering prayers of gratitude, but I began the month, on Respect Life Sunday, reflecting on the importance of praying for peace. As we come towards the end of October, I encourage you, as a family, to offer a prayer for peace and a prayer of gratitude for the peace you enjoy and the safety of your family at home, at school, at work, and at Church.

I believe that seeing the prayers of others is both encouraging and motivating. So, I once again ask you, if your family prays for peace, via a Rosary, Holy Hour, or participating in the Rosary for the Respect for Life, or any other form of prayer, drop us a note in the Prayers for Peace basket located in each of our churches. If you are looking for an easy way to meet this prayer challenge, here is one additional idea: offer your Mass for peace, as a family, before coming into the Church for Mass, make a commitment to offer that Mass for peace. Then, either at the beginning of Mass, when the priest says, "Let us pray," in that moment of silence, let the Lord know you are praying the Mass for peace, or during the Prayers of the Faithful, when we pause for those prayers in the silence of our hearts, identify your intention. Once completed, share this Good News with our community by dropping of that little note card in the prayers for peace basket. The baskets are near the entrance of the Church at Holy Trinity Church and Saint Malachy Church and by the ambo at Saint Mary, Help of Christians Church.

Let's Wear Green Next Weekend: Next Sunday, the Diocese is celebrating the Jubilee for Children with a special Mass at Saint Paul Cathedral. As a sign of hope, they are asking all to wear green to that Mass. Many of us will not be able to attend the Diocesan Mass, however, we can join in showing our hope for our children by wearing some green to Mass next weekend.

A Word of Caution: I hate that I must follow up such wonderful words of hope with a word of caution. However, I have been made aware that more frequent and more elaborate scams are being used to trick parishioners into sending money based upon my name, email, and now even phone number. Please remember that I will not contact you asking for money via phone, text, email, or any other non-personal way. If I we're going to personally speak to you concerning a financial need, I will do so face-to-face. 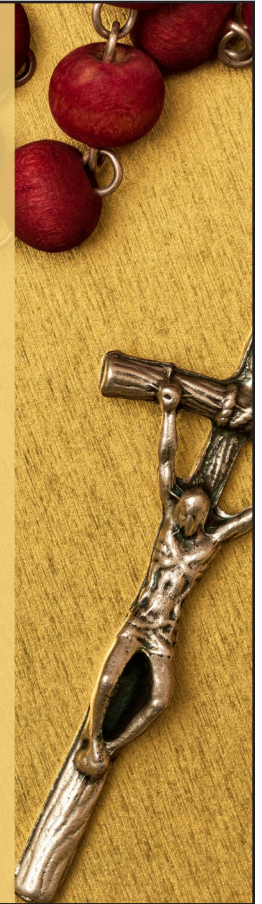

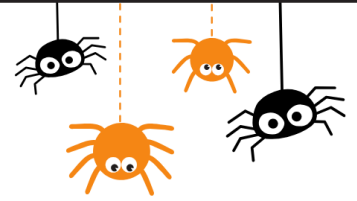

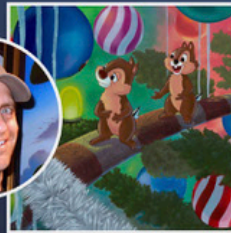
