### St. Malachy

by Thomas Merton

*In November, in the days to remember the dead  
When air smells cold as earth,  
St. Malachy, who is very old, gets up,  
Parts the thin curtain of trees and dawns upon our  
land.  
His coat is filled with drops of rain, and he is  
bearded  
With all the seas of Poseidon.  
Is it a crozier, or a trident in his hand?  
He weeps against the gothic window, and the  
empty cloister  
Mourns like an ocean shell.  
Two bells in the steeple  
Talk faintly to the old stranger  
And the tower considers his waters.  
"I have been sent to see my festival,"  
"For I am the saint of the day  
Shall I shake the drops from my locks and stand in  
your transept,  
Or, leaving you, rest in the silence of my history?"  
So the bells rang and we opened the antiphoners  
And the wrens and larks flew up out of the pages.  
Our thoughts became lambs. Our hearts swam like  
seas.  
One monk believed that we should sing to him  
Some stone-age hymn*

*Or something in the giant language.  
So we played to him in the plainsong of the giant  
Gregory:  
Oceans of Scripture sang upon bony Eire.  
Then the last salvage of flowers  
Fostered under glass after the gardens foundered  
Held up their little lamps on Malchys altar  
To peer into his wooden eyes before the Mass  
began.  
Rain sighed down the sides of the stone church.  
Storms sailed by all day in battle fleets.  
At five o'clock, when we tried to see the sun, the  
speechless visitor  
Sighed and arose and shook the humus from his  
feet  
And with his trident stirred our trees  
And left down-wood, shaking some drops upon the  
ground.  
Thus copper flames fall, tongues of fire fall  
The leaves in hundreds fall upon his passing  
While night sends down her dreadnought darkness  
Upon this spurious Pentecost.  
And the Melchisedec of our year's end  
Who came without a parent, leaves without a  
trace,  
And rain comes rattling down upon our forest  
Like the doors of a country jail.*

**All Souls' and All Saints' Days:** Our celebrations of All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day offer all of us a glimpse into the nature of the Church and the bonds that unite its members, both living and dead. Together, these solemnities express the doctrine of the "communion of saints," the belief that all members of the Church—those on earth, those in heaven, and those undergoing final purification—are joined in a single Mystical Body of Christ.

**All Saints' Day, which is normally a holy day of obligation, honors every soul who has entered into heavenly glory. This year it is not an obligation to attend Mass, however, I strongly encourage you to do so on Saturday morning at 8:30 AM in Saint Malachy Church.** The liturgy celebrates the "Church Triumphant," reminding the faithful on earth that sanctity/becoming a saint is the universal vocation we received at baptized. It directs our hope toward the ultimate goal of Christian life: eternal communion with God. This celebration is not only for the canonized saints recognized by the Church, but also the vast,

unknown multitude who lived lives of quiet faith and charity. That hopefully includes many of your friends and family.

The celebration is more than a memorial. It is an invitation to share in the joy of the saints, to seek their intercession, and to recognize in them what they modeled of Christian living. During a funeral homily, I like to find aspects of the deceased's life that point towards God and our call to be Christ to the world. I believe that each of us has a lesson to teach about being a Christian. All Saints' Day is a time to come to Mass to reflect upon the life of our favorite Church-recognized saint, but also a time to think of our deceased loved ones and the way they were Christ to us or Christ to the world. Saintry behavior, either from a declared saint or a loved one, is an example for us to follow to improve the world around us and grow closer to the Lord.

All Souls' Day provides a specific time for prayer and remembrance for the Church Suffering—those souls who died in a state of grace but are in a process of final purification before entering heaven. **Beginning at 4:00 PM on Saturday, November 1, the Church's Sunday celebration will be for All Souls' Day.** The foundation for this day is the belief that the prayers of the faithful on earth, particularly the sacrifice of the Mass, can assist the souls in purgatory on their journey toward Heaven. This is a day for us to remember to pray for our deceased loved ones and to pray for the poor souls in purgatory. All Saints' Day directs our gaze toward the glory of heaven, our ultimate destination. It reminds us of our charitable obligation to pray for those who are on the threshold of that same glory.

**Prayer:** At the end of August, Annunciation Church and School suffered a great tragedy. At the time, our parish offered prayers through the intercession of our patron, Gabriel the Archangel of the Annunciation. My heart still hurts for that community and I keep returning to the idea that our prayers should be known. I pray that they know they have not been forgotten. I had contemplated asking the parish to do a spiritual bouquet (a collection of prayers, Masses, Rosaries, and other devotional acts that are offered on behalf of another person) for the Annunciation community, and I may still ask. When I was applying to the seminary, I received a spiritual bouquet from the seminarians at Saint Paul Seminary, and it meant the world to me. I can't express how grateful I am that so many of you are praying for my health! I wish we all could experience the joy of knowing there are prayers being offered for us. Our parish does a very good job praying for others. We do a good job of making this visually known by our Intercessions page in our bulletin. Many of our parish groups are very faithful in praying for one another; we have groups specifically formed to pray for others; and we have some who are asking me to help them find the needs of our parishioners so they can pray for them. Soon, we will see our remembrance board displayed listing the names of those who had their funerals celebrated at our parish as a reminder that we continue to pray for them and their families. Prayer is the core of our life as Catholics and it should be highlighted. October will end my month-long challenge to pray for peace, but I hope it is only the beginning of our parish celebrating and recognizing our commitment to pray without ceasing.

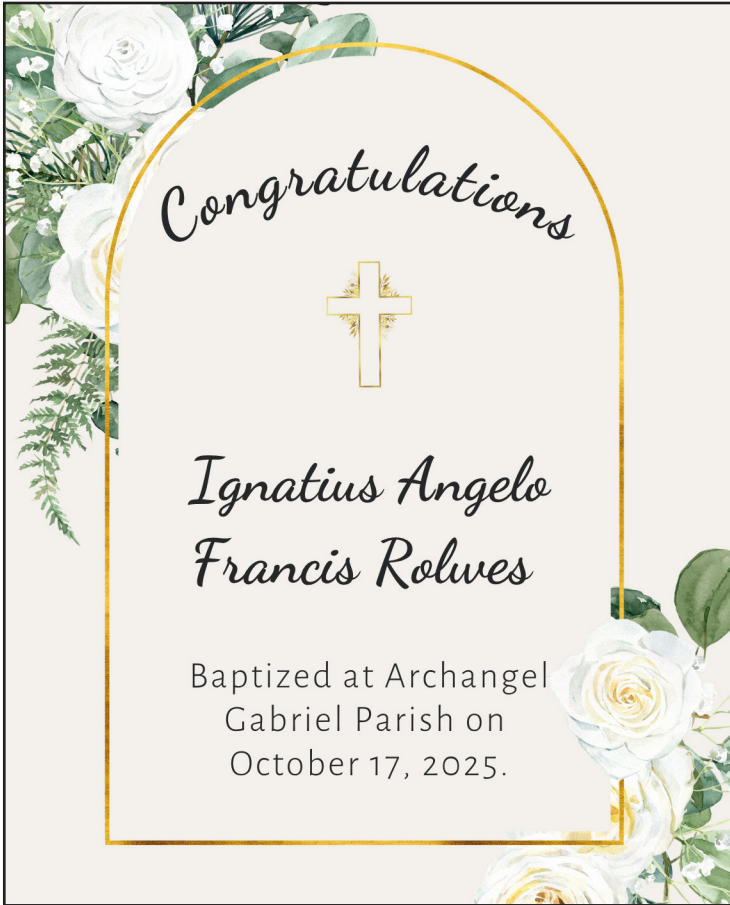

**Second Collection Next Weekend November 1 & 2**

The AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment.

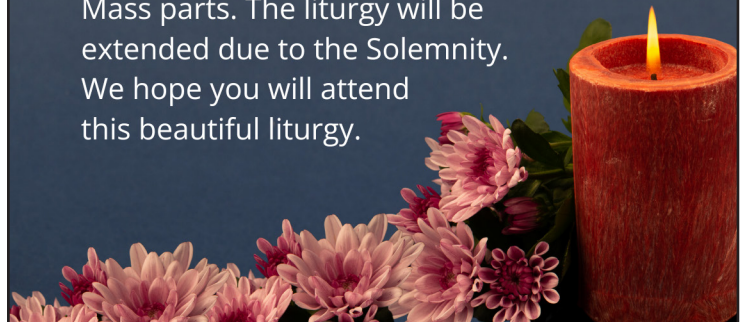

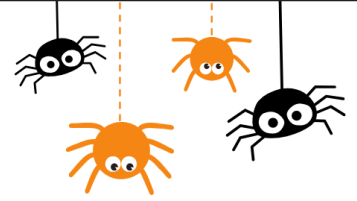
## LOOSE CHANGE SAVES LIVES BABY BOTTLE COLLECTION

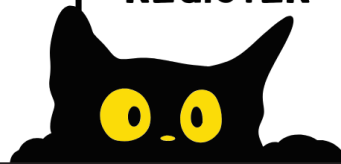
