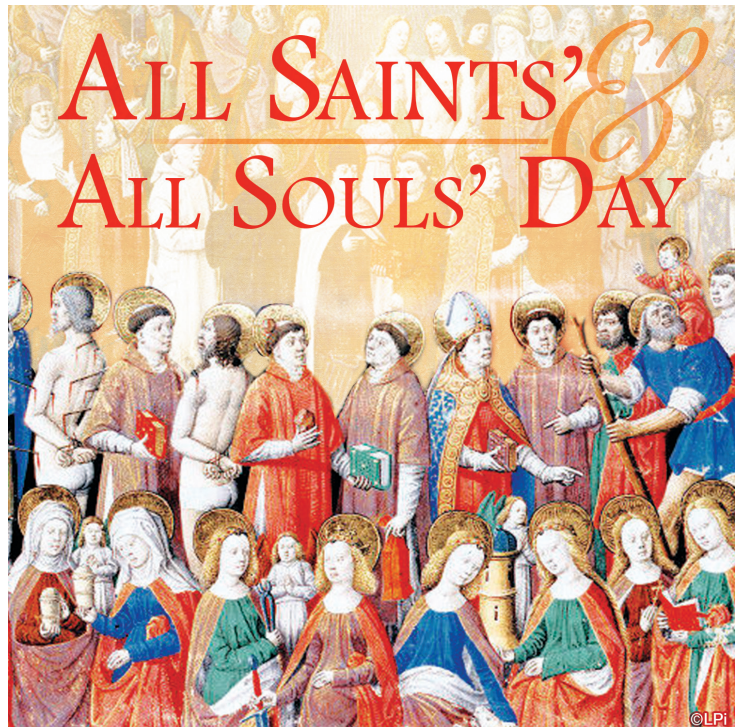
Security Alert - Fake Emails from Fr. Ken: Scammers are sending fraudulent messages that look like they are from me, using my real name, but from a fake, unofficial email address (like a random Gmail or Yahoo account). Please note that any communication I send WILL be from my Archangel Gabriel or Diocese of Pittsburgh email. If I were requesting a meeting with you, I will include a link to my booking page. I will never create a sense of urgency, asking for a "secret" or "confidential" favor or request that you buy gift cards or send money. For the most part, unless you sent me an email first, you should be very skeptical of any message you receive from me. If you receive a message from me that does not specifically identify why I am sending the message, or requests money or a favor I want to talk about, treat that message as a scam. Do not reply, do not click any links, and delete the email. If you are ever unsure of a message from me, please call the church office directly or email me at the address listed on our website to verify (kmarlovits@diopitt.org or kmarlovits@archangelgabrielparish.org).

November, A Month of Remembrance: This month is a special time for the Church to remember those who have died and gone before us. The world may see death as an absolute ending, but those of us with faith know that life is changed and not ended. The saying we are born into eternal life perhaps provides a better understanding that when our earthly bodies die, our soul moves forward in the journey. What is that journey? It is the same journey we are on now, our flight to heaven. The question is, do we have a direct flight, a one-stop ticket, or will we need to make some connections to reach our destination? We hope everyone has a direct and trouble-free flight from this world into the next, but hope isn't a wish. It is an active virtue, and November is when we highlight the need for our action. We are called to acts of charity and mercy, not only for our loved ones who have died and not yet entered heaven, but for all those departed souls (the holy souls in purgatory) who have no one else to pray for them.

Pope Benedict XVI observed, "The month of November draws its special spiritual tone from the two days with which it opens: the Solemnity of All Saints and the Commemoration of all the faithful departed." The focus on the communion of saints and the prayers for the deceased shape the whole month, encouraging the faithful to unite their own prayers with those of the saints and to offer works of charity for the souls in Purgatory. The Catechism explains that all who die "in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven" (CCC1030). Because the souls in purgatory are already united with Christ but still need to be cleansed, the Church teaches that we the faithful on earth can help them by prayers, almsgiving, acts of charity, and especially by the sacrifice of the Mass.

This month, do something special for the poor souls caught up in travel delays and help them reach their (and hopefully our) final destination.

All Saints' Day Reminder: All Saints' Day, which is normally a holy day of obligation, honors every soul who has entered into heavenly glory. This year it is not an obligation to attend Mass, however, I strongly encourage you to do so on Saturday morning at 8:30 AM in Saint Malachy Church.



REGISTER BY NOVEMBER 30

Children who are baptized, have reached or will soon reach the age of seven, and are currently in second grade or above (having already completed a full year of religious instruction, not counting Kindergarten), are eligible to receive the sacraments of First Penance and First Communion. **If you would like for your child to receive these sacraments at Archangel Gabriel Parish in the spring of 2026, please register them no later than November 30, 2025. Your child must be registered in order to receive the Sacraments at Archangel Gabriel Parish.**

To register your child for First Penance & First Communion 2026:

- **Watch the parent video** located on the "Parent Video" tab of the portal. The video will contain instructions on how to register your child and information regarding the preparation process that must be completed in order to receive the Sacraments.

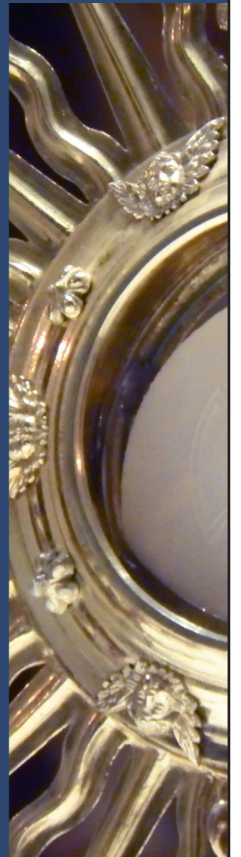

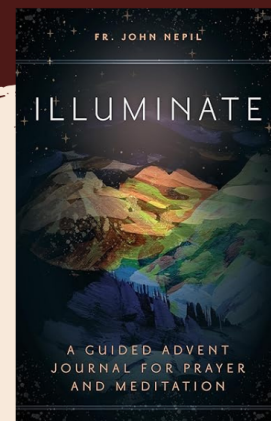

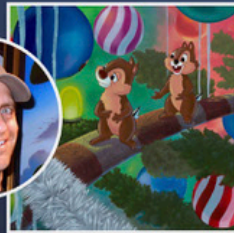
