Active Participation in the Church: We hear about active participation in the Mass, but what about active participation in the Church? As Catholics, we are familiar with the terms time, talent, and treasure. These are three ways in which we are all called to contribute to the life of the Church. The Church is a single reality, but it manifests itself at different levels of human life. Thus, "Church" can rightly describe the family, the parish, and the broader local community. Each is a concrete way of expressing the one "mystical Body of Christ." We are called to be actively involved everywhere the Church is present in our lives, so I invite you to think of how you are active with your time, talent, and treasure in your family, the parish, and our community.

Reflecting Upon Our Gift of Time: The Second Vatican Council described "the spiritual worship holy and acceptable to God" as taking place in daily life, lived in charity through the free and generous gift of self. As we approach the end of the liturgical year (November 30), it is a good time to reflect upon how we use our

time and what new year resolutions we might want to make. We should ask ourselves if we are giving more than just the time it takes to travel to, attend, and return from Mass each weekend. Do we take extra time each day to pray, to read scripture, to spend time with the Lord? Can we find time during the day to stop into the Church to pray, to pray an hour of Adoration, to attend the Thursday night Holy Hour, to participate in a Third Place Saturday, or to attend a social function at the Church? Are we offering time in service to others? For what do we volunteer to help our parish or our local community? Is there a parish ministry of service or a civic service organization that you have considered joining? Do you spend time with the elderly, the lonely, your parents, your children, your family? How often do you eat a meal together (without your phones or the TV)? Are you offering up your daily, mundane tasks—your job, your studies, your chores—to God. By doing them diligently, ethically, and with a spirit of love, your work becomes a prayer and an offering of time.

Reflecting Upon Our Gift of Talent: The Church teaches that the Holy Spirit bestows a variety of charisms/talents to all the faithful, which are to be used for the common good. Offering our talents is about discovering, developing, and deploying our God-given skills and abilities for the good of others and the glory of God. We should examine our life to see if we are using our God-given talent to build up the Church (family/parish/community). Are we giving our best to our family, not holding back, not refusing to give of ourselves? Do we share with the parish by filling roles that we are capable of doing, such as reader, usher, greeter, extraordinary minister of holy communion? Do we sing in the choir? Are we teaching or proclaiming the faith to others? Is our talent volunteering to work the pizza kitchen, fish fry, or Nationality Festival by cooking, cleaning, or taking orders? Do we have talents that would benefit others, like listening, offering professional guidance, or praying? Is our talent a ministry of presence, an ability to lift heavy objects and set-up (or clean-up) the Church or hall? Can we paint a room, cook food, make raffle baskets? Are we willing to discover new talents, like making blankets or "street" evangelizing? Whatever talent you have, or want to learn, is a talent that can be used to build the Church.

Reflecting Upon Our Gift of Treasure: I honestly believe the best treasure is you! Your presence to your family, the parish, and the people of God you encounter in your daily activities is what matters most. However, treasure does refer to all the financial and material possessions God has entrusted to you. Like time and talent, the core principle is that none of it is truly yours. It is all a gift from God, and we are simply stewards called to use it wisely and generously for his purposes. It is the tangible fruit, the product of our God-given time and talent. Therefore, offering our financial goods is a way of giving a portion of our very selves back to God. Offering our treasure is not a transaction, but an act of worship. It is a profound demonstration of gratitude for the life and skills He gave us; it is a detachment from the idolatry of wealth and a symbol of our trust that he will faithfully provide for our family, parish, and community.

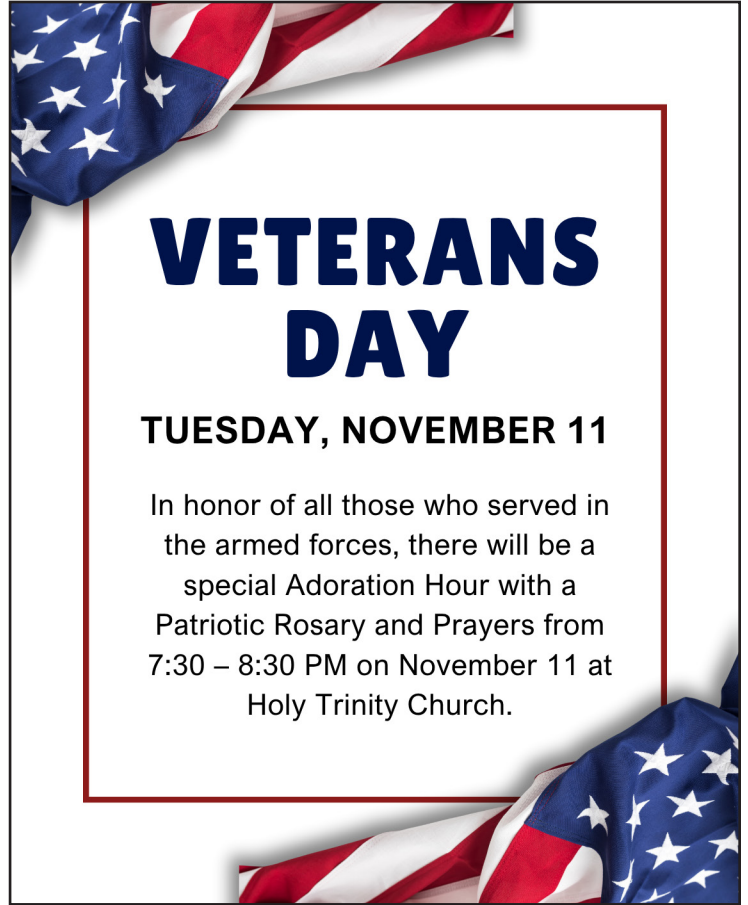

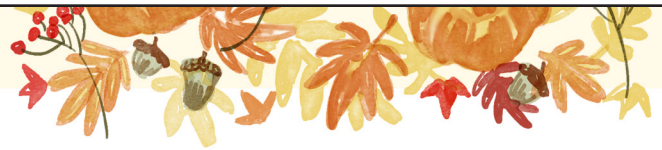

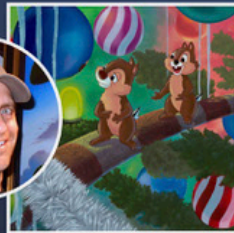
