3 | MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

A Blessed 4th Sunday of Advent & Merry Christmas! While we should remain focused on these final days of Advent, I recognize that many of you will soon be traveling and spending time with family and friends away from the parish. Because of this, please allow me to extend an early, heartfelt wish for a very merry and blessed Christmas! Know that as we offer the celebration of the Mass, you will be lifted up to the Lord in prayer, praise, and thanksgiving. Archangel Gabriel Parish is a special place because of all our parishioners. May God protect your travels and bring you back to your parish home safely.

A Final Push Towards Christmas: For those who participated in the Hallow Advent Prayer Challenge, we have been reflecting deeply on the topic of "Being Still." We have journeyed with Mary and Joseph—whose lives were surely chaotic—to see how trusting the Lord can bring profound peace. Silence, stillness, trust, and love have been the path we've walked these past 20 days. As we enter this final push toward Christmas, we must be mindful not to let the worldly chaos

overtake the spiritual calm we have been invited to cultivate.

Take time to be still. Remember to pause and settle your heart and mind with Jesus. A few moments of stillness can give you the strength you need to conquer the storm—the noise that comes with a large family, the cooking, the gift wrapping, the preparation of cookies and milk for Santa (and carrots for his reindeer). A quiet moment with the Lord will allow you to find gratitude, transforming these demanding opportunities into blessed moments of encounter.

Encountering the Newborn King is a Reality: As we prepare to celebrate the birth of Christ, the King of Kings and Prince of Peace, let us be fully aware that we, like the shepherds and the Wise Men, truly do meet him. This is not merely the celebration of an historical event. This is the celebration of God being born into each of our lives anew today! Are you willing to meet this newborn King, our Savior and Redeemer? Are you willing to encounter God himself? As we adore the infant lying in the manger, we prepare our hearts to recognize him in the faces of others. Emmanuel comes to us wrapped in ordinary human flesh, inviting us to see his divine light shining within every person we encounter.

Just as the light of the Star of Bethlehem guided many to the stable to come and adore Jesus, allow the Church to guide you to him as well. To help you maintain that quiet, receptive heart of Advent, allow me to highlight one way our parish provides a unique and powerful opportunity for stillness, silence, and trust: Adoration of the True Presence.

Here are the ways you can adore the Lord at Archangel Gabriel Parish:

- **Extended Adoration:** We offer two sessions of extended adoration. One session runs in the morning following daily Mass at both Saint Mary, Help of Christians and Saint Malachy Churches and concludes at noon. The other session follows the evening Mass at Holy Trinity Church on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, ending at 10:00 PM. We are looking for committed adorers. Can you spend one hour of silent prayer with the Lord? If so, please sign up online or contact the Parish Office. If you are not sure, give it a try for a few weeks and see if it works, then sign up.
- **Thursday Evening Holy Hour:** Unlike the other opportunities to adore the Lord, which are private, our parish holy hour is a celebration fostering our sense of community while supporting one another as the Body of Christ. These Holy Hours include scripture, a homily, prayers of the faithful, and praise and worship music. All are welcome.
- **Stop at Holy Trinity Church for a Visit:** Adoration of our Lord via a visit to a church is, and remains, the normal and most common mode of adoration for Catholics worldwide. Holy Trinity Church is open seven days a week for such visits.
- **Family Adoration:** On most first Fridays of the month, we offer family-friendly adoration at Holy Trinity Church from 1:30 - 4:00 PM. This time is designed to allow "children to be children" in the presence of our Lord. It's an opportunity to introduce your children to adoration in an environment where they are free to move around, ask questions, and not worry about disturbing others. You do not need to stay for an hour; you are invited to come and stay as long as your family is able.

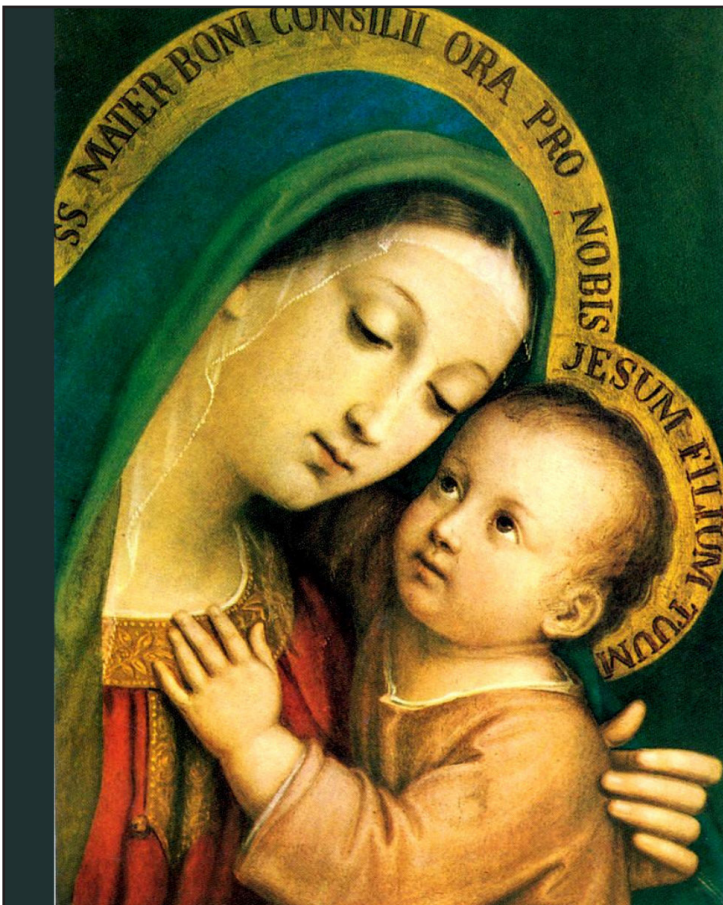

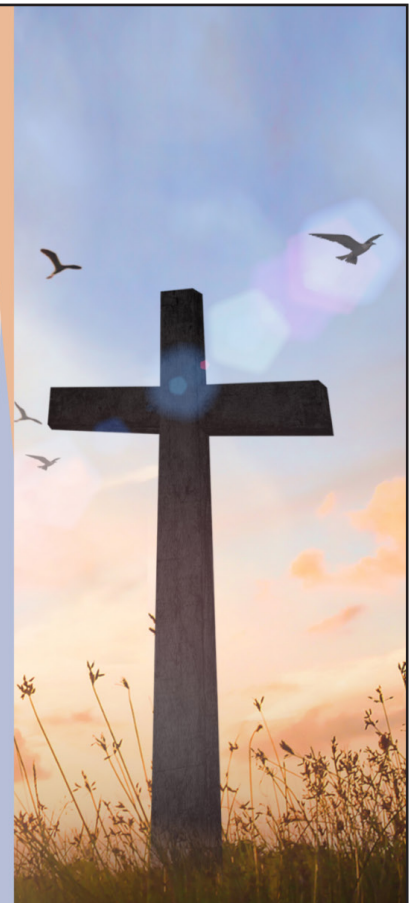
