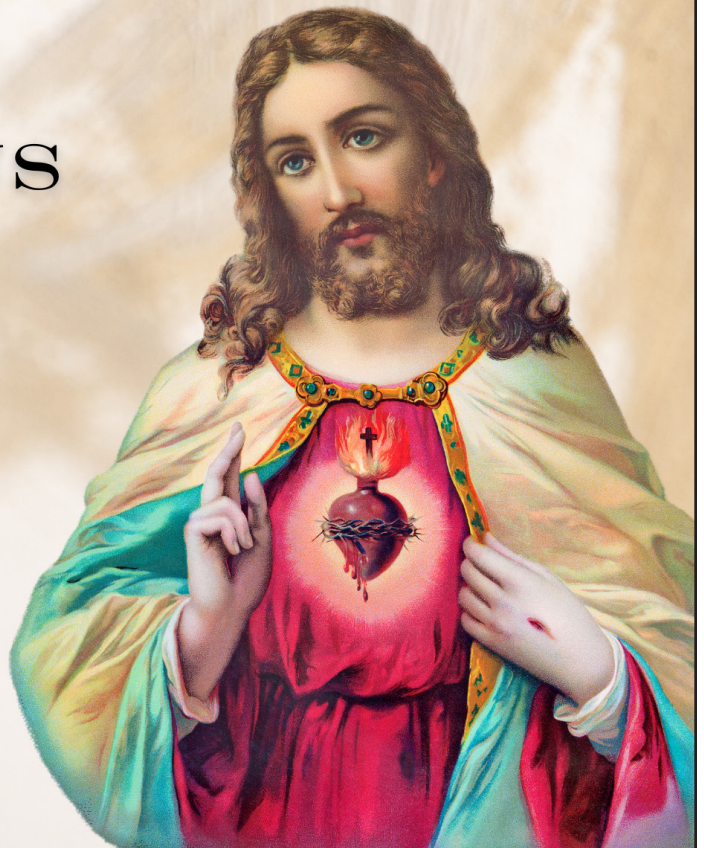

MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

June: A Month Dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: Father Jacob and I are big fans of Divine Mercy Sunday – I'm sure you all noticed with our extra-long homilies (or hopefully the extra joy with which we preached)! During those homilies, I often noted that for earlier generations, the same message of God's most generous love was powerfully expressed through the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

As we enter June, we're invited to continue contemplating the Lord's boundless love for us. June, dedicated to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, is a profound invitation to deepen our relationship with Christ and grow in the understanding of true love. It is a special time for Catholics to focus on the true meaning and definition of love as we celebrate our faith.

The Sacred Heart, often depicted with a crown of thorns, a cross, and flames, is a powerful symbol of Jesus' boundless love, compassion, and mercy for humanity. It represents his perfect sacrifice, his burning desire for our salvation, and his enduring presence among us. It also beautifully symbolizes how sacrifice, suffering, carrying our cross, and purification are not only realities of life, but also blessed graces of God's love.

As June unfolds, let us make it a time to truly solidify the transformative lessons of Easter - especially the immense gift of Mercy - within our daily lives. May we all **contemplate his love** via our prayer and meditation, focusing on the immense love the Sacred Heart pours out for us. **Receive him in the Eucharist**, which is the ultimate expression of Jesus' self-giving love. Perhaps you can make an extra effort to attend a daily Mass where you can receive Holy Communion or commit yourself to praying before the Lord during Adoration or the Parish Holy Hour, where we receive him spiritually. **Practice Acts of Reparation** for our world, which is marked by indifference, confusion, and sin. We are called to make amends for the offenses against God's love committed not only by ourselves, but by the entire world. May we do this, for the sake of Jesus' Most Sacred Heart and the Blood and Water which gushed forth from his heart, through prayer, penance, and acts of charity.

The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is on Friday, June 27. This important day also marks the **World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests**, established by Saint John Paul II in 2002. This day serves as an occasion for the Church to unite in prayer for and support its priests in their sacred ministry, while also encouraging priests to reflect deeply on their vocations and renew their commitment to holiness. The Parish Holy Hour on Thursday, June 26 (7:30 - 8:30 PM at St. Malachy Church) will focus on the Sacred Heart and will include prayers for the priests of our parish and those who serve in our Diocese.

Spiritual Renewal: Hopefully you have begun praying the Novena to the Holy Spirit, which is a powerful way for individuals and communities to seek spiritual renewal, fresh grace, and a greater awareness of God's presence and action in their lives. The fullness of this novena is received on Pentecost, when we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Church.

Pentecost Luncheon: You're invited to celebrate the Birthday of the Church with us at our Pentecost Lunch! The clergy of Archangel Gabriel Parish felt called to celebrate you, our incredible parishioners. We want to honor all you do to support our parish and especially how you bring Christ's love into the world through your words and actions within our communities. Your dedication truly makes our parish vibrant! Consider this free lunch our heartfelt thank you – a small token of our immense gratitude for you, the Mystical Body of Christ, who help our community experience the profound love of Jesus. Please join us on Sunday, June 8 from 11:30 AM to 3:30 PM in Weirauch Hall (below St. Malachy Church).

Pentecost Vigil Mass: On June 7, at the 6:00 PM Vigil Mass at St. Mary, Help of Christians Church, we will be celebrating the Extended Vigil Mass. Rooted in the apostolic tradition of prayerful anticipation, the extended vigil is a time of intense preparation for the reception of the Holy Spirit that unites the faithful in prayer and reflection as we await the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. I invite you to come (dressed in red) and celebrate this special liturgy. There will be music and additional readings, so please plan accordingly; this Mass will be longer than the normal 6:00 PM Mass.

THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION Sunday, June 22 | 12:00 PM | St. Paul Cathedral, Oakland

We invite parishioners to join other Catholics in the Diocese on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (June 22) for a Corpus Christi Mass and Procession! Mass will begin at 12:00 PM at St. Paul Cathedral; the procession will begin between 1:15-1:30 PM. We will process on a flat, one-mile loop through the streets in Oakland, stopping at three different altars along the route for readings and benediction. The procession is expected to last approximately one hour.

AGP has chartered a bus to transport parishioners to this event. The bus will depart from the parking lot at St. Malachy Church promptly at 11:00 AM and return at approximately 3:15 PM. If you would like to reserve a seat, **please register at ArchangelGabrielParish/CorpusChristi or call the Parish Office at 412-787-2140.** Registration is limited to 45 people, however, a second bus may be chartered, depending on the number of registrations. There is no cost to attend.

The Diocese welcomes all parish organizations, altar servers dressed in alb or cassock and surplice, First Communicants in their dresses or suits, neophytes, recently received individuals into full communion of the Catholic Church, families, the young and the old to attend. NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

Join the AGP Family in Praying the Novena to the Holy Spirit.

The novena in honor of the Holy Spirit is the oldest of all novenas since it was first made at the direction of Our Lord himself, when he sent his apostles back to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Spirit on the first Pentecost. It is still the only novena officially prescribed by the Church. Addressed to the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, it is a powerful plea for the light and strength and love so sorely needed by every Christian.

Join your fellow AGP parishioners in praying the powerful Novena to the Holy Spirit in the nine days leading up to Pentecost from Ascension Thursday. It takes less than 10 minutes each day, and there are several ways you can participate.

- The novena will be prayed at the end of all morning Masses at St. Mary and St. Malachy Churches and the evening Masses at Holy Trinity Church, beginning on Ascension Thursday (immediately following Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, when applicable).
- The novena will also be available online each day via YouTube at tinyurl.com/PrayHolySpirit.

Note: Due to other celebrations, the Novena will be prayed before Mass at Holy Trinity on May 30 and June 3.

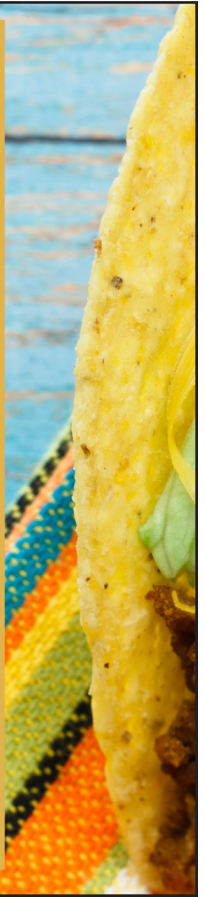

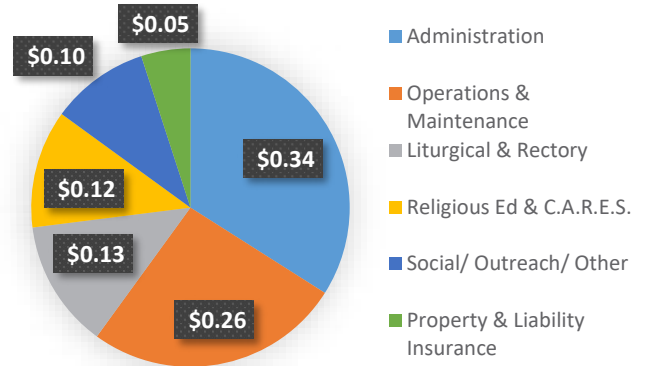
