PARISH PRIORITIES UPDATE

Priority 1: Establish habits of grateful disposition, hospitality, and inspirational preaching and music.

Leader: Deacon Tim Killmeyer | **Priority Liaison:** Linda Gomulka

This priority seeks to ensure our parish promotes inclusiveness to all persons as a Child of God and a member of our faith family. The Sunday experience has primary focus, but it is not the only aspect to be addressed. Sunday liturgies are being improved via ongoing training of ministers, reintroduction of the Precious Blood, heightened attention to celebrations (i.e., Epiphany Blessing, Word of God Sunday, Candlemas, Anointing Masses) ongoing livestreaming, and the sending forth of our Eucharistic Ministers from Mass directly to our sick and homebound to ensure a direct connection with the community that prays with and for them.

We have also been attending training at the diocesan level to ensure we are aligned with all relevant policies. We will soon be updating some ministries and launching new opportunities to ensure our parish is a place of welcome that leads all to praise the Lord with grateful hearts.

Priority 2: Lead all to know, call them to, and support them in their next step following Jesus.

Leader: Steven Swank, Director of Faith Formation | **Priority Liaisons:** Patty Sampogna and Erica DeNucci

The parish continues to develop ways for all to deepen their faith and knowledge of Christ and the Church. We continue to work with our ministries to feed off of each other to promote a progressive journey with the Lord. Our OCIA program (Christian Initiation) is adapting to new guidelines and adjusting to align the needs of those entering the Church and the gifts of who are walking with them. A period of mystagogy following the Easter Vigil was highly successful and the clergy team is seeking to be more involved in Family Catechesis this upcoming year.

Perhaps the most exciting aspect of our parish life is the collaboration between Priority 2 and Priority 4. Working together, plans are being developed, with hopes of launching in the fall, combined events of evangelization and outreach. The plans are exciting but still at the very early stages, so I will leave you with this as a tease for what is to come. But the Holy Spirit is alive and well, so stay tuned!

Priority 3: Communicate to build engagement and mutual appreciation among parishioners and neighbors.

Leader: Deena Swank, Director of Communications (serviced by parish staff at this time)

Having met our established parish goals for this priority, namely completion of the parish census and an increase in our email and Flocknote communication, this priority has undertaken the step of discerning new goals moving forward. At this time, the new goal for our parish communications is to establish a system of integration with the other priorities to increase the effectiveness of our messaging and event and ministry promotion.

Moving forward, Priority 3 will cease to exist and the other priorities will be incorporating specific communication goals in conjunction with their action items and specific needs. The hope is that moving to an integrated approach to communication, rather than a standalone approach, we will be able to establish a more streamlined approach, resulting in greater promotion of the wonderful works and opportunities our parish offers.

PARISH PRIORITIES UPDATE

Priority 4: Actively connect neighbors through mission driven outreach.

Leader: Fr. Jacob Gruber, Parochial Vicar | Priority Liaisons: Tom Adams and Anne Koller

Exciting new opportunities are extending our parish mission to the larger community. This includes an evangelization team being present at our Farmer's Market, participation in local events, such as the Good Friday Cross Walk, McKees Rocks Be My Neighbor Day, and community events ranging from the Blessing of the Bikes to the Kite Festival, where our parish is able to steward our gifts in ways that build the initial relationships needed to build the trust that becomes the foundation upon which one can proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Current ministries are being expanded and seeking new ways to serve. The campus at Saint Malachy is currently being studied as a space that may allow our outreach ministries to have the space needed to expand and serve more of the members of our community.

Priority 5: Align parish finances, personnel, activities, and properties for mission vitality and for modeling stewardship.

Leader: Ken Zern, Director of Operations (serviced by parish staff at this time)

In preparation for the new fiscal year, which begins July 1, several important activities have been undertaken to meet our parishes' needs. A review of all employee job descriptions has been completed, and the employee handbook has been updated to meet current law. The 2026 budget has been submitted, as required by Diocesan Policy. A review of most important repairs for the buildings and grounds has been conducted, and these projects have been assessed and prioritized (water backflow issues for the rectory, church, and Gathering Place at the Saint Mary Campus, Electronic Signage, rectory and building usage at the Saint Malachy Campus, clergy office space, school building needs at the Holy Trinity Campus, and parking lots at all three campuses).

This priority will be removed from the oversight of the implementation team and placed under the direct supervision of the newly constituted Parish Finance Council once the members are formally commissioned at the beginning of August.

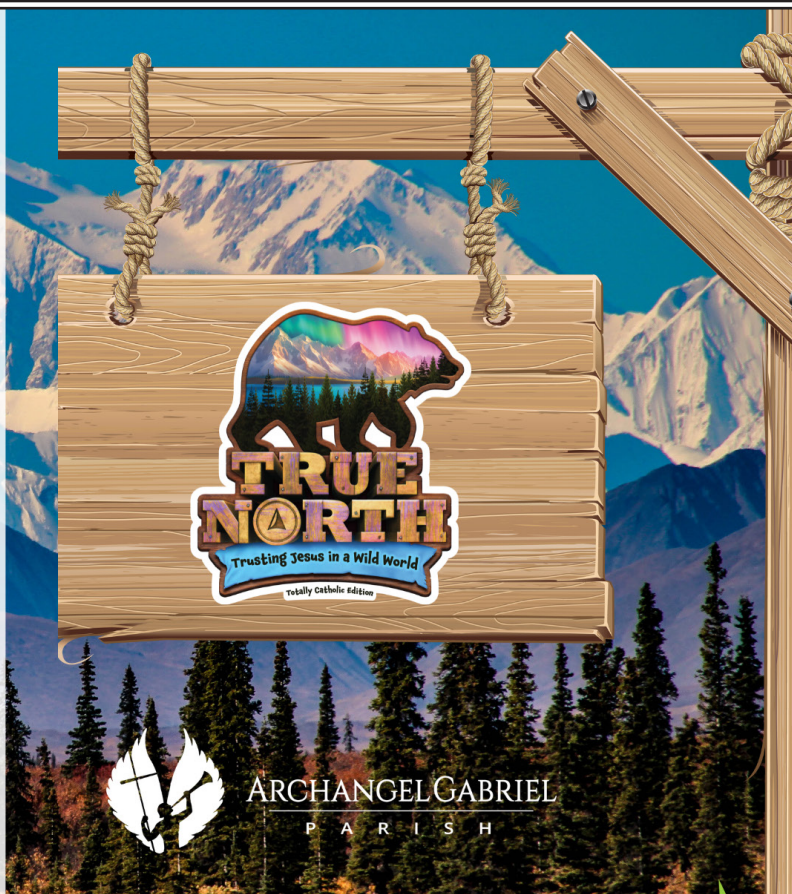

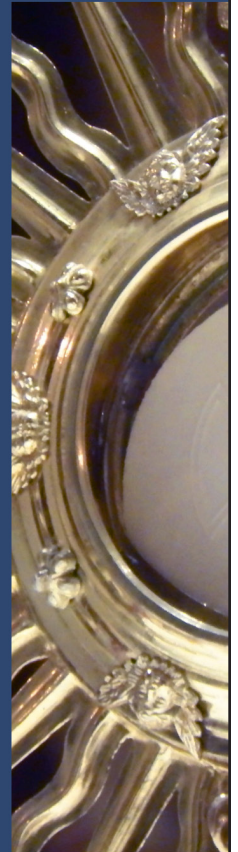
