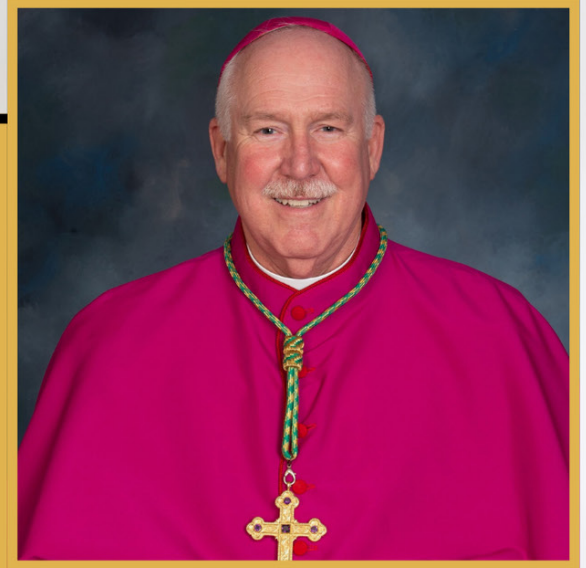

The Holy See announced on June 4, 2025 at 6:00 AM that Pope Leo XIV has accepted the resignation of Bishop David A. Zubik, who reached the mandatory retirement age of 75 this past September. At the same time, the Holy Father has appointed Auxiliary Bishop Mark A. Eckman as the 13th Bishop of the Diocese of Pittsburgh.

Bishop Eckman will be installed on Monday, July 14, 2025, during a special Mass at Saint Paul Cathedral in Oakland (time TBD).

MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

Pentecost and the Graces of the Holy Spirit: Today is the day we've eagerly anticipated and prayerfully prepared for with the Novena to the Holy Spirit. We celebrate receiving God's blessings in our lives within the Church and our very being. We are called to be missionary disciples, engaging with God's life-giving and sustaining grace and our journey with grace reflects God's immense love for us and the world. It's important to discover our unique gifts in His plan, bringing purpose and meaning to our hearts and allowing us to go forth as the Light of Christ. For this to happen, we must seek a deeper understanding of and the courage to boldly live our charisms - special gifts from God given for the benefit of the Church and the world.

We can categorize graces into three types, each supporting you and the Church in unique ways. Some are given equally to all, while others are distributed universally, but with varying degrees of ability. Finally, certain gifts are reserved for special situations. Regardless of whether you call them charisms, graces of the Holy Spirit, natural gifts, or charismatic gifts, recognizing their purpose helps us

reflect on how God, particularly the Holy Spirit, empowers us to live the Joy of the Gospel.

The Graces of the Holy Spirit: Grace is first and foremost the gift of the Spirit who justifies and sanctifies us. But grace also includes the gifts that the Spirit grants us to participate with His work, to enable us to collaborate in the salvation of others and in the growth of the Body of Christ, the Church.

At Baptism, where the Holy Spirit is poured out in fullness, grace is freely and equally bestowed upon all, empowering us to sustain the Christian moral life. This equal distribution of the Holy Spirit fosters unity in our faith, as we are all given the totality of what is needed to be Children of God. One can truly think of these gifts as the means to help us live the Christian life.

Natural Gifts or Talents: These are the inborn talents God bestows upon each of us from the moment we are formed in the womb. While everyone possesses these gifts to some degree, their prominence and specific expression vary from person to person. We call them "gifts" because they are freely given by God, enabling us to contribute positively to society and bring him glory. By utilizing them to fulfill our calling and serve the Body of Christ, we actively participate in his divine plan.

St. Paul lists many spiritual gifts, or "charisms" (see Ephesians 4:7-13 and 1 Corinthians 12:1-12), some of which are natural gifts developed through life experience and personal abilities. For each of us these serve as powerful indicators of our natural areas of ministry, the places where we would most readily excel and make a significant impact. It's beneficial to cultivate and use these gifts throughout your life. The process of discovering these charisms and how God would like us to use those gifts is called discernment. As we discover our gifts, both our expected and surprising gifts, the unique plan God has for us will be revealed. Those gifts were given for a reason. The application of those gifts, if we wish to find peace in our lives, must be what God is asking us to accomplish. Think of these as your developed talents, which you're uniquely called to share with your community.

Charismatic Gifts (The Manifestation of Gifts): These gifts are supernatural abilities bestowed upon individuals by the Holy Spirit. They are not natural talents, but rather divine manifestations intended for the common good of the Church. It's crucial to understand that these gifts are never meant to promote the importance of the person through whom they operate. We don't "possess" these manifestation gifts; instead, we are vehicles the Lord uses for the outpouring of his blessings upon his people. Therefore, when we exhibit these gifts, we are 'gift bearers' and must function with humility, a willingness to take risks, complete trust in God, and profound love for our brothers and sisters in Christ.

Think of these gifts as something God dispenses sovereignly according to his will. They are not earned or learned; instead, they are given at specific times for the betterment of the community and the Church.

Our Mission: As we steward God's gifts and mysteries to make missionary disciples for Jesus Christ and His Church (our parish mission statement), it will be necessary to discern our gifts, talents, and charisms. Keep an eye out for news and information that will help all members of our parish discern their place in God's world and open new opportunities for each of us to go forth proclaiming the Gospel and glorifying God by our lives.

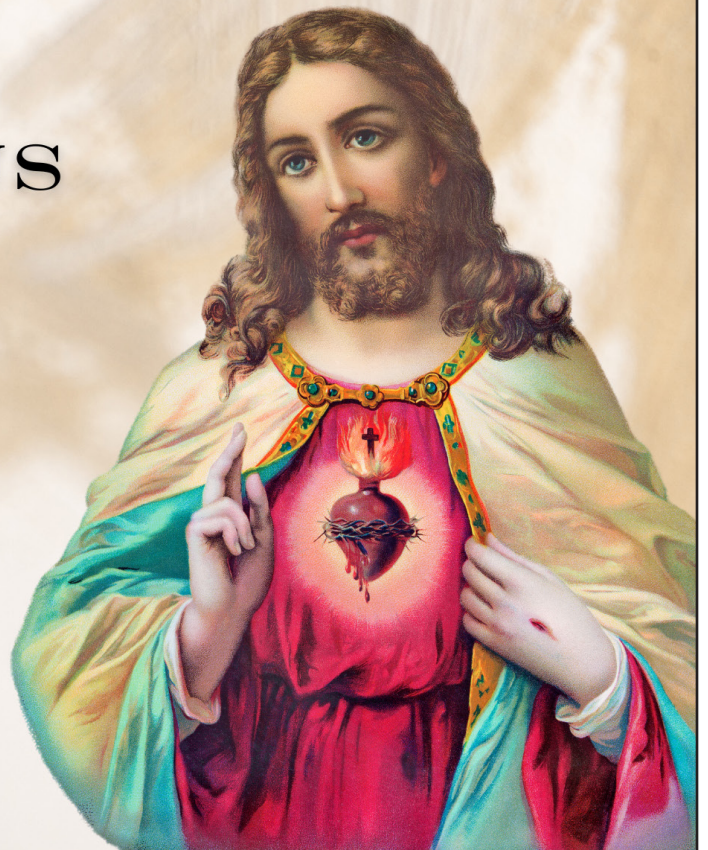

Living Rosary for the Health of Priests in our Parish and Diocese



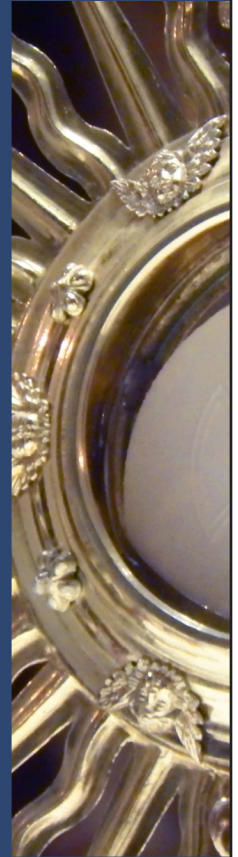
