MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

Thank You, Congratulations, and Good Luck: We want to wish Isabella Hinline and her husband Stephen, a word of congratulations. They are expecting their first child in January! Such a life change is a blessing and a major turning point in a married couple's life. After many prayers to Saint Joseph and much discernment, Isabella and Stephen have decided to move to her hometown of Fort Wayne, Indiana, to have familial help, love, and support surrounding them. With this move, Isabella is leaving the position of Coordinator of Youth and Young Adult Ministries effective this weekend. She shared with me that "these past two years working for Archangel Gabriel Parish have been a blessing," saying that "it truly was such an honor to help lead our youth closer to Christ and to help provide opportunities for young adults and families to encounter Christ." I can assure Isabella that we too have enjoyed her ministry to our parish family and that she will be missed, but also prayed for. Isabella was very dedicated to walking with our middle school parishioners in the EDGE program, our high school youth in Life Teen, and with our young adults and young families with different events,

opportunities, and of course starting our Family Adoration on first Friday's. Thank you, Isabella. Know of our prayers for you and your family!

Good News in the World of our Young Adults: Youth and Young Adult Ministry often goes unnoticed. You may wonder how successful our programs are and if our young adults are vibrant and faithful. Honestly, that is very hard to determine. However, if we look to our parish mission and vision (Stewarding God's gifts and mysteries to make missionary disciples for Jesus Christ and His Church) we have a mechanism to gauge our success. I want to highlight three of our young adults to show that our parish is succeeding.

Collin Foster: Collin will be entering Saint Paul Seminary next month to begin his Propaedeutic Stage of Seminary, where he will discern a possible call to the priesthood. Collin is a native of Virginia, works in the field of cyber security, and has family in California. He decided to join our parish because he "was attracted to our heartfelt worship in daily Adoration and the parish Holy Hours, as well as seeing the vibrant community of families and people of all ages." Collin is an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion and frequents daily Mass as his work schedule allows. But best of all, he is a graduate of Penn State! I'll follow up as he makes this journey so we can support him in his discernment and growth in the faith.

Rachel Kuchnicki: Rachel is currently biking 600 miles from Columbus, Ohio, to St. Louis, Missouri, as a missionary with Biking for Babies. This ride is a public witness to the dignity of human life, an advocacy for women and families in unplanned pregnancies, and serves to raise awareness and funds for pregnancy resource centers. Biking for Babies is one example of how growing in virtue, the love of Jesus Christ, and self-knowledge can lead to embracing the missionary spirit. Rachel will share her insights and testimonial on this unique style of missionary work (one I think Deacon Tim loves) in an upcoming bulletin.

Oliva Robb: Olivia is a missionary with FOCUS, the Fellowship of Catholic University Students. We often think of college as a time when our parishioners fall away from the faith. But because of the work of people like Oliva, there are college students going to Bible studies, having radical conversions, committing their lives to Jesus, sharing their faith, and mentoring other students in the faith. As a FOCUS missionary, Olivia meets students, share her life with them, and invites them to intentionally pursue the Lord and watch him work in their lives. She relies on the spiritual and financial support of mission partners, so she really must place her trust in the Lord. She cannot do the work without the generosity of those who support her spiritually and financially. Olivia would love to share more about this mission! You can reach out to her at 412-860-3914, to set up an individual appointment, but hurry! She can only meet sometime this week.

These three young adults of our parish are just a quick look into how the Lord is inspiring members of our parish to follow his voice and go out into the world as a disciple of Christ. But it is not only young members of our parish doing crazy missionary work. Please pray for Fr. Lou (and Fr. Dave Poecking) as they are in Tanzania, sharing the Good News while giving talks and hosting conferences. Let us offer prayers for their missionary success and their safe return.

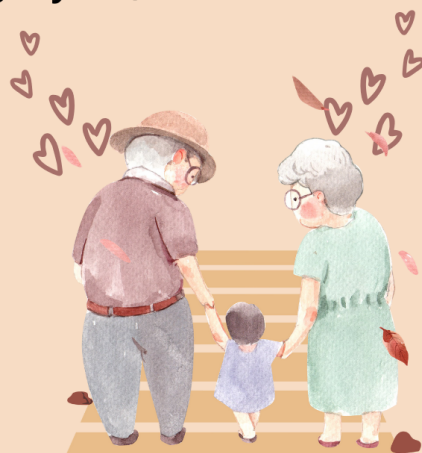

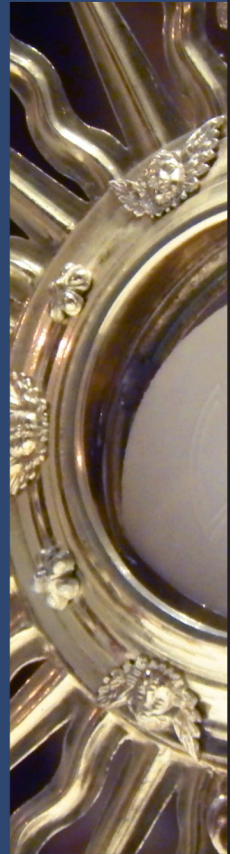
