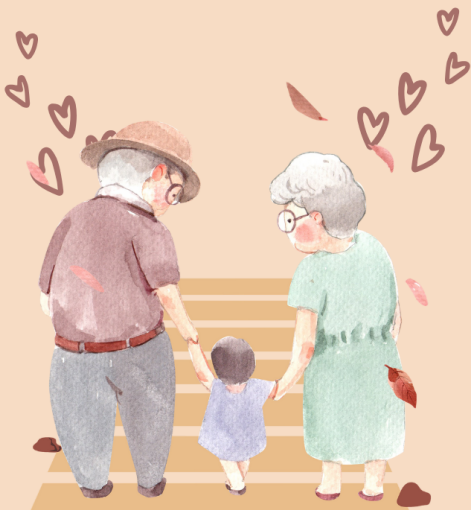

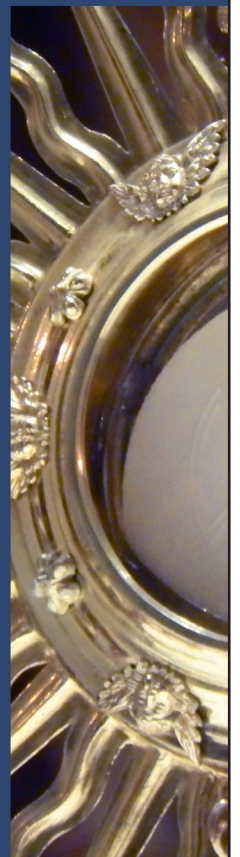

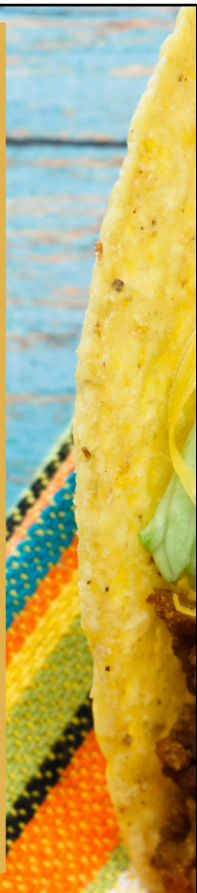

BEGINNER'S T'AI CHI CLASS

MONDAYS, STARTING SEPTEMBER 8 | 6:30 - 7:30 PM
YOUTH MINISTRY CENTER, ST. MALACHY CAMPUS

Are you interested in maintaining or improving your balance, flexibility, and coordination? The Chinese art of T'ai Chi Ch'uan is known to do all of that and lower blood pressure, strengthen bones, and increase the range of motion of the joints (especially in the hips, knees, and ankles). It is considered a moving meditation that combines the coordination of breathing with series of slow, deliberate body movements. T'ai Chi's slow, relaxed, rhythmic movements relieve stress and promote relaxation. These low-impact movements are great for older individuals (regardless of health issues) and provide younger folks with an exercise that only gets better the older they get.

Deacon Tim has been studying T'ai Chi for over 40 years and would like to share what he has learned with the men and women of the parish. Classes will be held on Monday evenings, from 6:30 - 7:30 PM in the Youth Ministry Center, beginning September 8. Lessons are free, but if you decide to continue after the first class, it is expected that you will make it a regular commitment. 
