MESSAGE FROM THE CLERGY

One of the sayings in seminary that I disliked was “don’t take a vacation from your vocation.” It was used to remind us seminarians that when we were not at the seminary, we were still supposed to keep up with our prayers. I disliked it because of the implication that our spiritual growth was simply a “special” job we were being trained for and not a radical falling in Love. If we needed a vacation from our vocation, it seemed to me that we were doing something fundamentally wrong. We are Christians, we don’t merely “do” Christianity.

However, I will admit that the desire to take time away from all this religious stuff is real. This desire speaks directly to our relationship with God. When this feeling arises within us, we should take note. It is important time to ask if we have made our relationship a job. Are we checking boxes and fulfilling obligations, or are we walking hand-in-hand with the one we love. This applies to all of our relationships, but most especially our relationship with the Lord. Are you in love with the Lord, or do you work for the Lord?

July is popular for vacations. So, this seems like a good time to ask if you have, or are thinking of, taking a vacation from our faith. If you have, I would ask for you to think less about what you are doing and more about the One whom you love. Perhaps you need a new method of prayer, or you need to learn more about him by taking an online class. You may need to start to experience him through service to his brokenness in the least of our brothers and sisters, or via a greater participation in the Liturgy as a reader, cantor, choir member, usher, greeter, or extraordinary minister of Holy Communion. The important thing is to encounter him, not work for him.

On the other hand, maybe the summer is the time where you can think about taking a vacation to him. Do you have more time this summer to court the Lord? Maybe you could fill that time by spending an hour in private adoration, attending the Parish Holy Hour, going to a daily Mass, returning to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, attending one of our fellowship or prayer groups, or incorporating the Rosary into your daily life. Whatever you do, do it for the Lord, and do it with the Lord, not as an obligation or a job, but as the most satisfying, loving relationship you will ever know.

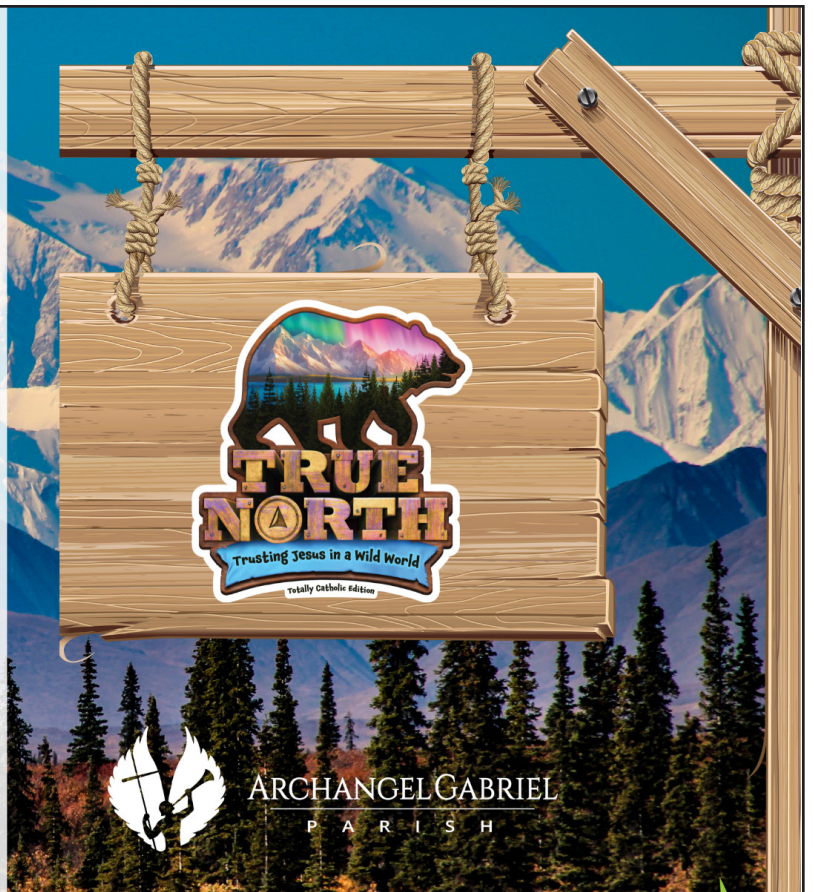
