Installation of the Pastoral and Finance Councils: On Sunday, August 17, at the 10:00 AM Mass, we will install the new members of the Parish Pastoral and Finance Councils. Following the Mass, there will be a small reception.

The **Pastoral Council** is an advisory body that collaborates with the Pastor to guide all aspects of parish life. Its members use their unique skills and spiritual gifts to strengthen the community, assess its needs, and advise the Pastor on strategic planning, as well as the creation and review of the Parish Pastoral Plan to grow the parish in ministry, participation, mission, and discipleship.

In fulfilling its responsibilities, the Pastoral Council must be committed to prayer and the values of the Gospel and be knowledgeable of the mission of the Church and the distinctive characteristics of the parish, its ministries, and its people. In consultation with the Pastor, the Parish Pastoral Council actively listens to, identifies, and responds to the hopes, needs, and concerns of all parishioners.

The new members of the Parish Pastoral Council are; Linda Gomulka, Shawn Mulvay, Ashley Person, Patti Phillips-Best, Linda Schroeder, Karen Simpson, Bill Stropkaj, and Isaac Summers.

The **Finance Council** is an advisory body to the Pastor that assists in the administration of the temporal affairs of the parish and in the management of parish goods. The work of the Finance Council is to aid and advise the Pastor in the areas of financial planning; budgeting, accounting, and transparency of reporting; oversight of proper controls; and education on stewardship and fundraising/development activities. The skills and expertise of its members are utilized to strengthen and monitor the financial activity of the parish. In fulfilling its responsibilities, the Finance Council must be directed by the values of the Gospel as well as good business practice.

The new members of the Finance Council are; Tom Adams, Joe Bayer, Ryan Blinn, Rosemary Corsetti, Michelle Green, and Donna Spohn.

Post Holy Hour Celebration: Do yourself a "flavor" and come pray with us on Thursday, August 21, as we host a Rita's Italian Ice social following the 7:30 PM Holy Hour at St. Malachy Church. Pope Francis said, "While no one should feel obliged to spend an hour in adoration each Thursday, the practice ought surely to be recommended. When we carry it out with devotion, in union with many of our brothers and sisters and discover in the Eucharist the immense love of the heart of Christ, we adore, together with the Church, the sign and manifestation of the divine love that went so far as to love, through the heart of the incarnate Word, the human race."

Other Parish Updates:

- St. Mary's water backflow preventer system needs a custom-made part. We are awaiting its delivery. Once installed, this new system will meet the requirements of the water authority and ensure the safe delivery of water to all three of our buildings (Rectory, Church, and Gathering Place).
- St. Malachy's electronic sign has been professionally evaluated, and it has been determined that it is too costly to repair. The sign is not a standard unit; it was put together using different components, making it almost impossible to find proper replacement parts. A committee is examining the most effective and affordable alternatives to replace it.
- Holy Trinity Campus signage, most notably, the old brick sign, will be removed in the coming weeks. A new sign, listing Mass and confession times will soon be placed at the Steubenville Pike entrance.
- We will soon begin acquiring bids to address the needs of our parking lots at all campuses. This process is complex and made possible due to refunded money the parish has acquired. More details will be coming soon as we publish our year-end financial statement.
- To assist our parishioners in hearing the Mass, a study was conducted on a loop hearing system, similar to the one used at St. Paul Cathedral, which allows those with hearing aids to directly connect with the sound system. Unfortunately, the architectural design of the church will not support such a system. We are currently investigating other options.

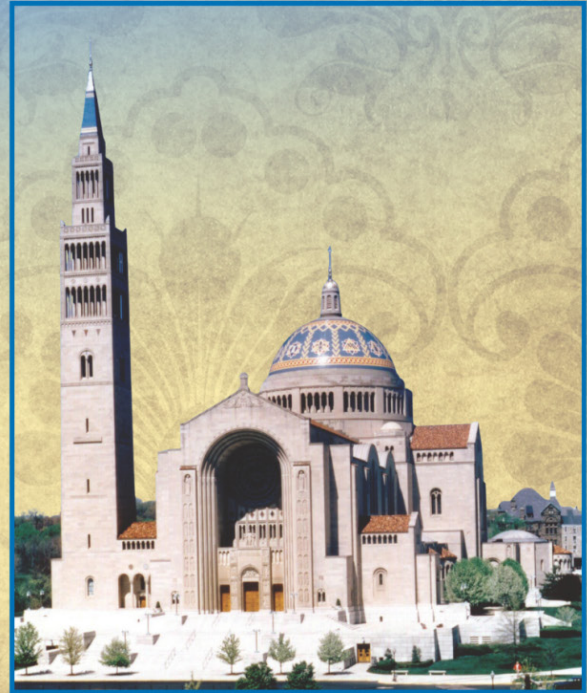
