Policy and Procedure for Proposing a New Parish Initiative

At Archangel Gabriel Parish, we are blessed to have many projects, groups, and activities to help people grow in the faith, pray and enter into liturgy, and get more involved. These reflect the many gifts given by the Holy Spirit to the people of our parish and quite a bit of planning and effort by so many generous souls.

As we grow and continue to respond to the calling of God in our parish, we aim to have an open disposition toward new projects, groups, and activities. But we also want to make sure that these new initiatives align with the mission and vision of the parish. We also want to make sure that they have all the resources necessary to succeed.

Baptized Christians already have the right and responsibility within their own lives, homes, and families to incarnate the mission of the Church in new and creative ways, and so all are already able to start whatever initiatives they wish on their own accord. All are called to be missionary disciples, and small groups

can be started in any place. But a new level of discernment, order, and care comes in when such an initiative comes under the care of a Catholic parish and when such activity benefits from promotion by the parish.

A Catholic parish must have a particular prudence about how it starts new projects, groups, events, and activities, since it needs to satisfy the: 1) missionary calling of Christ; 2) the universal law of the Church (Canon Law) and the particular law of the diocese; 3) civil law; and 4) good order among existing parish activity and good stewardship with regard to resources and facilities.

In an effort to provide guidance for the creation of new parish initiatives (events, fundraisers, organizations, etc.), the parish is implementing a new proposal procedure. We've also consolidated and formalized the policies governing use of parish facilities and the creation and operation of parish initiatives.

Under the WELCOME tab on the parish website, you will see a new subheading called PLAN AN EVENT. This section contains several pages with information to guide the planning of new and existing parish initiatives, including:

- **Event Planning & Promotion**
Provides guidance on planning and promoting a parish initiative
- **Facilities Calendar**
Shows the use of our facilities and which are available
- **Parish Facilities**
Describes all available parish facilities, with the exception of the churches
- **Policies for Parish Projects, Groups, Events, or Activities**
Lists policies governing facilities use and creation and operation of parish initiatives
NOTE: These policies take the place of all former policies for facilities use, including the Narthex policy.
- **Propose a New Parish Initiative**
Explains the process that will be followed to begin a new parish initiative
NOTE: Established/recognized parish organizations and ministries who are planning previously-approved events, fundraisers, etc., are NOT subject to this process; they can request facilities use with the Facilities Form, as they have in the past.
- **Reserve a Facility**
Contains the form to reserve a parish facility for an approved initiative

ATTENTION FIRST GRADE PARENTS:

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING FIRST PENANCE & FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

In the Diocese of Pittsburgh, children are eligible to receive the Sacraments of First Penance and First Holy Communion at the end of their second year of formal religious education. This means that for children to receive the sacraments in the spring of second grade, they must attend some sort of religious education (parish faith formation program, Catholic regional school, Catechesis of the Good Shephard, etc.) while they are in first grade. Here, at Archangel Gabriel Parish, we offer Family Catechesis as the religious education program for families with children in grades K-5.

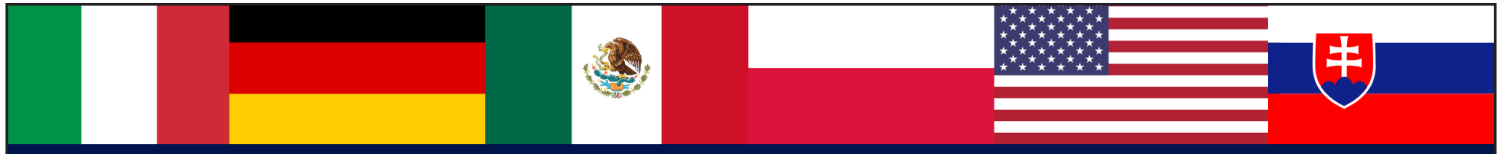

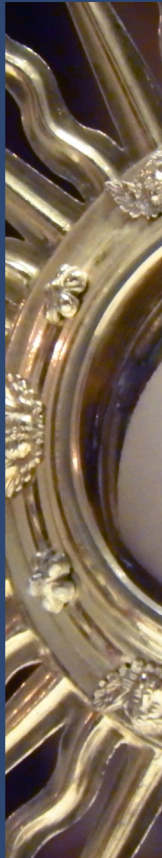
