NATIONAL FARMERS MARKET WEEK 2024

August 4-10, 2024

A look back before moving forward: I am amazed that back to school commercials and football training camps have already begun. August is upon us, and a new school year is kicking off. Personally, I feel like Christmas was a few weeks ago. Time is flying by and, honestly, it is stressful. I have so much to do, but I seem to lack the time to accomplish it. This causes stress, and stress actually makes me less productive and causes me to fall even further behind. But in stressful times, where the clicking of the clock adds pressure to my life, I often think of Saint Teresa of Calcutta, Mother Teresa.

Mother Teresa is famous for telling her sisters, who were complaining about how much work they had and how little time there was, that they needed to spend more time, not less, in prayer. The sisters apparently had gone to Mother Teresa with the idea to gain more time to help accomplish their work by cutting back the time they spent in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. Mother Teresa's response was to tell them that if they felt they didn't have enough time, they should spend two hours in Adoration, not one. So more time in prayer, not less,

was her solution to being busy.

Grounding your life in the Lord is the only way to truly relieve stress and find peace. There are many ways to relieve stress in our life, but to do so in a way that also brings true peace is hard. Often our stress reducing method for dealing with an overloaded schedule is to remove items from our to-do list. But what if those items are not impersonal tasks, but opportunities to love and serve others? Do we feel good about eliminating these? Or do we merely ignore our emotions and detach from the world? Many stress relief strategies have us prioritize ourselves in a self-centric, self-absorbed way that actually leads to isolation, depression, and looking for artificial ways to fill the loneliness that arises. However, turning to Jesus, both relieves the stress and connects us with God and our neighbor. Prayer provides the relief and the relationship that we need!

Let's look back at a few ways the clergy has invited you to deepen your prayer life and extend to you once more an invitation to deepen your stress-relieving prayer life.

To celebrate our parish's fifth birthday on January 6, we launched our new **Parish Holy Hour**, held every Thursday evening from 7:30 - 8:30 PM at Saint Malachy Church. Unlike our nine other adoration periods throughout the week, this Holy Hour is a public prayer experience. It includes a brief scripture reading, a reflection or homily, prayers of intercession, and, on occasion, a special devotion - like the Patriotic Rosary we prayed for the nation on July 3rd. There is also praise and worship music alongside peaceful moments of silence. It's interactive and participatory, yet deeply personal. If you haven't joined us yet, give it a try; you won't regret it! As an extra incentive, mark your calendar for August 21. That evening's Holy Hour will focus on the Queenship of Mary, led by Deacon Tim, and will be followed by a refreshing Rita's Ice social.

Do you remember Word of God Sunday (January 26)? We set up trees with envelopes in all our churches, inviting every family to choose a **Family Scripture Passage** for the year. Did you pick one? And more importantly, do you know where it is now? My passage, Matthew 16:24, is taped right above my computer in my personal office, so that when I lift my eyes from the computer screen, I'm drawn back into that personal relationship with Jesus, who is the Word. It's also a constant reminder of what the Lord called me to focus on this year. Has the Word of God become a daily presence in your life and your family's? Are you still praying with your scripture?

During Lent, the clergy offered the **Hour of Grace Lenten Challenge**, an invitation to spend one additional hour a week with the Lord. This hour could have been spent in various ways: within the parish church (attending daily Mass, Adoration, the Holy Hour, or simply stopping in to pray); in the domestic church (such as reading the Bible for 10 minutes each day at home); or within the communal church (spending time with the parish family). Did you participate in this challenge? Have you continued to dedicate an additional Hour of Grace in your life? Would you consider adding that hour to your week now? Remember, this hour with the Lord can be prayer, service, or simply social interaction with fellow parishioners.
