School is in session; it's time to learn: The start of the new school year is a good time to establish a goal to learn something new about the faith. Do you have a plan? Have you recently taken a course, attended a seminar, or read a book to expand your knowledge of our Catholic faith? The parish has many opportunities for in-person learning and these opportunities are expanding, but remember we also have free online options accessible under the GROW IN THE FAITH tab on the website. FORMED is an online video, audio, and ebook library with access to thousands of movies, programs, and books instantly. FRANCISCAN AT HOME is online learning with Franciscan's renowned catechetics faculty and field mentors. Learning about the faith is both fun and rewarding, so let's all make it a goal to learn something new.

Season of Creation: The annual ecumenical celebration that honors God's gift of nature and creation begins on September 1 with the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. This year's theme is "Seeds of Peace and Hope." In Pope Leo's

message about this celebration, he stated: "In proclaiming the Kingdom of God, Jesus often used the image of the seed. As the time of his Passion drew near, he applied that image to himself, comparing himself to the grain of wheat that must die in order to bear fruit (cf. Jn 12:24). Seeds are buried in the earth, and there, to our wonder, life springs up, even in the most unexpected places, pointing to the promise of new beginnings. We can think, for example, of flowers springing up on our roadsides from seeds that landed there almost by chance. As those flowers grow, they brighten the gray tarmac and even manage to break through its hard surface. In Christ, we too are seeds, and indeed, seeds of peace and hope."

This image of the seed is a powerful metaphor. Once baptized, we are seeds of faith, called to spread throughout the world, bringing God's beauty and the Good News of Jesus Christ to both hospitable and inhospitable places. Like a flower that brightens a roadside, we are meant to flower - to show the beauty of love, compassion, forgiveness, patience, humility, and mercy. Just as one flower has the power to change our focus from the dreariness of a roadside, one Christian's life is enough to draw people away from the temptation of evil towards the hope found in the beauty of Love.

This year's biblical passage for the season is Isaiah 32:14-18. Therein, we are told the spirit of God makes an arid and parched desert into a life-giving oasis of peace. We are the recipients of God's grace, the seeds of Jesus Christ himself, and we are the one's called to be the fruit of the Holy Spirit! We become, for others, that place of rest from the evil of the world. We, by our thoughts, words, and actions [I confess ... that I have greatly sinned in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done, and what I have failed to do...] must go into the world and manifest the goodness of our Lord.

The celebration of creation not only reminds us to be grateful caretakers of the gift of our planet, but it calls us to ponder nature itself. When we reflect on that lone flower on the side of the road, the beauty of a sunrise or sunset, the power of water, the peacefulness of the forest, the produce of plants that began as a seed, we can do so prayerfully and be led into a deeper understanding of God and our faith. When we reach the celebration of Saint Francis, the patron saint of animals and ecology, we will have the blessing of pets, a very visible way to give thanks to God for the creations with which he has blessed us, but I hope that we all will be able to point to something concrete in creation that has allowed us to see and understand more fully the beauty of God in our lives. Remember, we are the seeds of Peace and Hope. Go forth and beautify the world.

ARCHANGEL GABRIEL PARISH KNIGHTS IN ACTION: JANUARY TO JUNE 2025

Since 1993, the AGP Knights of Columbus Council #11279, and its legacy councils at St. Malachy and Holy Trinity, have been dedicated to raising funds and devoting countless hours for many local charities and causes for the parishes, as well as for the community at large. In the interest of keeping parishioners apprised of our continued activities, we will be presenting a Knights in Action report on a quarterly basis. To kick it off, and to catch up, we are reporting our activities for the first two quarters of 2025:



- Between July and December 2024, we made \$10,479 of aggregate donations to various worthy causes in addition to participating in various other projects.
- In January, we held a Knight's Free Throw Championship at AGS with 40 participants.
- The Council purchased Miraculous Medals for each newly baptized baby.
- \$719 was donated to the AGS Teachers Appreciation Luncheon.
- The Council held its annual Night at the Races fundraising project in February, providing the parish with a night of fun and socialization.
- Various Brother Knights worked at the Parish Fish Fry during Lent.
- \$2,175 of net donations were made to the Pennsylvania Knights of Columbus Chance of a Lifetime (COAL) sweepstakes to support College Scholarships and other charitable programs.
- \$492 was donated to purchase prayer books for the OCIA retreat.
- Brother Knights joined the Respect Life Group as they prayed outside of Planned Parenthood.
- Brother Knights staffed the Archangel Gabriel Parish Kite Festival at Youthtowne, where Brother Tim Burke's Cooked Goose Catering donated food.
- \$8,000 was raised by Council members for the Choices Walk for Life efforts.
- The Council held a Firepit Social, welcoming the Catholic Men's Fellowship group to join us for casual fraternity in May with two more scheduled this year.
- \$1,500 was donated to the Pentecost Luncheon; the Council also cooked hamburgers and hot dogs for the event.
- The Council awarded two \$1,000 Scholarships to graduating AGS students.
- The Council donated \$480 for essay awards for AGS graduating students and a school plaque.
- Various Brothers have assisted in setting up and breaking down the weekly Farmer's Market.

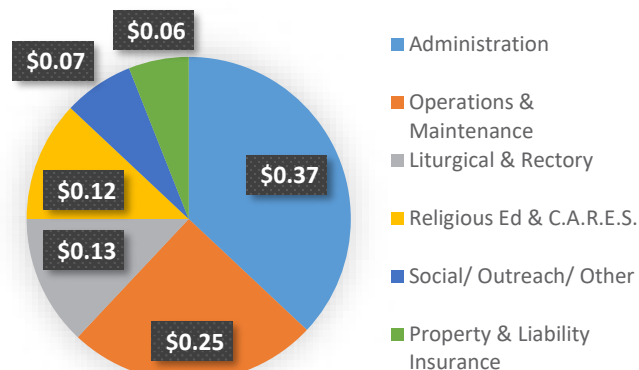

This page contains the financial statement for Archangel Gabriel Parish for the fiscal year which ended on June 30, 2025. The cash surplus for the year amounted to \$585,315. The primary reason for the surplus related to the parish receiving a net refund of \$432,543 from the Internal Revenue Service for Employee Retention Credit. The Employee Retention Credit was a benefit provided under the CARES Act to assist private-sector businesses and tax-exempt organizations that were financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. The parish qualified for this credit in conjunction with the Paycheck Protection Program, which was federal initiative to provide financial assistance during the COVID-19 pandemic to help retain employees.

These proceeds that were received have been designated to be used for capital projects, including parking lot maintenance and improvements at all three AGP campuses.

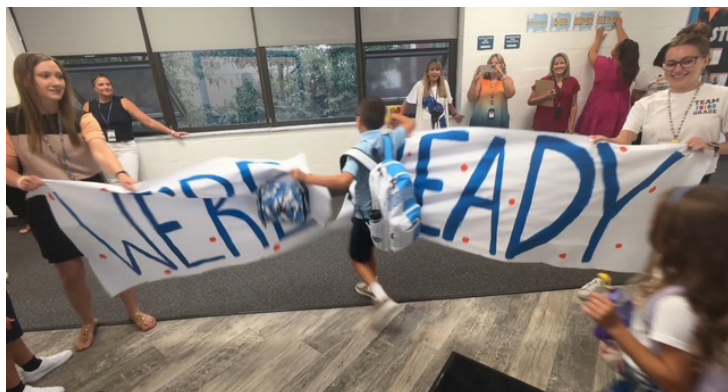
