### A MESSAGE FROM FR. KEN MARLOVITS, PASTOR

A Merry and Blessed Christmas to all who gather with us today at Archangel Gabriel Parish. On this holy day, we celebrate the most transformative event in human history: the birth of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. This is the moment when God himself entered our world, not with power and thunder, but as a vulnerable infant, so we could witness his love for us without fear.

This day, we celebrate the mystery that the eternal, omnipotent Son of God took on human flesh—true humanity—to dwell among us. This is what we mean when we proclaim Jesus as Emmanuel, which means "God is with us." Through the Incarnation, we realize that all humanity is sacred and that heaven has been opened to us. This is a house of God, and you are part of our family today. We pray that as you experience the joy of our Mass, and you feel the profound peace and love that only the Christ Child can bring. 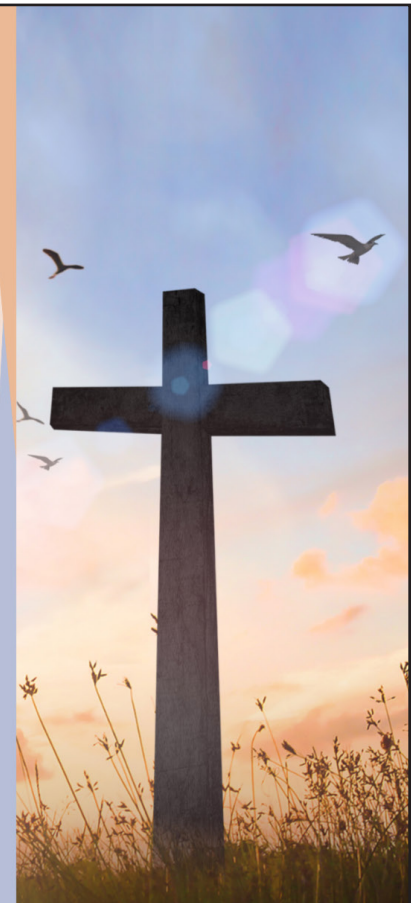

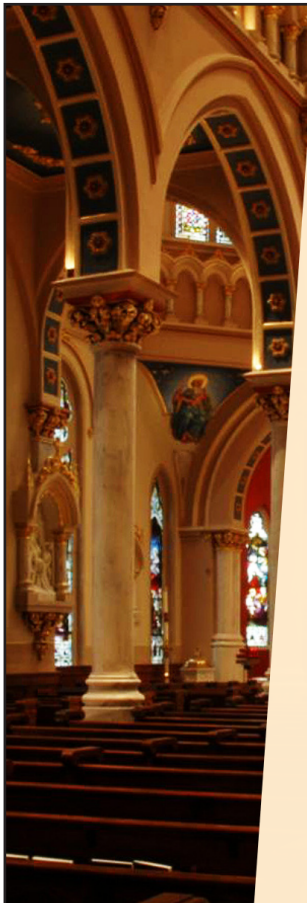

***Anointing Mass***

**Sunday, February 15 | During 12:30 PM Mass  
 Holy Trinity Church**

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after anointing but becomes ill once again, or if, during the same illness, the person's condition becomes more serious. A person should be anointed before surgery or when a dangerous illness is the reason for the intervention. Moreover, older people may be anointed if they are in a weak condition, even though no dangerous illness is present. Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be comforted by this Sacrament.

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be in God's will, the person will be healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age. The Anointing of the Sick is one of two sacraments of healing, the other being the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

All those who wish to be anointed should check in prior to the start of Mass at the registration table in the Narthex. You will be directed where to sit, and the priests will come to you for the Sacrament.
