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3 | MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

The final two weeks of January are filled with special remembrances and observances within our faith. It begins with the week of prayer of Christian Unity, and includes the Day of Prayer for the Protection of the Unborn, Word of God Sunday, and Catholic Schools Week. February starts with the celebration of World Day for Consecrated Life, and plans are being made for our parish to host the diocesan-wide celebration for our men and women religious. Our Ordinary Time isn't slow! Please remember these events in your prayers.

Christian Unity Week (18-25): Each year, representatives from various Christian communities gather to pray together "that all may be one" (John 17:21).

God of all, we pray as one, that we may be one, just as the Lord Jesus prayed we may be one in Him. Your son Jesus compels us to be reconciled to one another. May our spirits be joined to Your Holy Spirit, that we may witness to the visible unity of your Church. May we all recognize that we are truly one with You, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and grow together in peace. We ask this in the name of Jesus our Lord. Amen.

Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children (22): This prayer acknowledges that when we respect the life of the unborn, it will undoubtedly lead us to respect all human life.

O Jesus, you came that we might have life—and have it in abundance. Together with the Father and the Holy Spirit, you form us in our mothers' wombs and call us to love you for all eternity. As your most precious gift of human life is attacked, draw us ever closer to your Real Presence in the Eucharist. Dispel the darkness of the culture of death, for you are the light that shines in the darkness, and the darkness cannot overcome it. By the power of your Eucharistic Presence, help us to defend the life of every human person at every stage. Transform our hearts to protect and cherish all whose lives are most vulnerable. For you are God, forever and ever. Amen.

Celebrating Word of God Sunday: Third Sunday of Ordinary Time

Next Sunday, the Catholic Church celebrates Word of God Sunday. Established by Pope Francis in 2019, this day reminds us that the Bible is not just a historical book, but a living encounter with Christ. As St. Jerome—the great translator of the Bible—famously said: "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ. When we hear the Word proclaimed at Mass, it possesses a "sacramental power." It doesn't just tell us about God's will; it gives us the grace to put that will into practice. We are a "People of the Book," and next weekend is a beautiful opportunity to recommit ourselves to the B.I.B.L.E.—the Basic Instructions Before Leaving Earth—which Sacred Scripture provides for us!

Family Scripture Scrolls: To help our parish family bring the Word into our homes, we will once again invite families to take a Scripture Scroll from our Tree of the Word. This practice is inspired by a Vietnamese Catholic tradition I encountered during my time at Saint Paul Seminary. I have personally been moved to pray with my own "Holy Spirit-chosen" scripture for the past six years, and I have never been disappointed. Each year, I am amazed by how the Lord places the perfect Bible verse into my life at just the right time.

How it works:

- **Pick an Envelope:** Next weekend, you will see a Christmas tree adorned with envelopes.
- **Receive Your Word:** When you pick an envelope for your family, you will receive a specific biblical verse and a prayer intention. [A select few will also contain \$5.]
- **Live the Word:** We invite you to be creative! Place your verse on the refrigerator, include it in family prayer time, or use it as a discussion point during Sunday dinner. The way your family chooses to use your scripture verse is less important than making it a part of your life!

I truly believe the Holy Spirit guides which envelope each family chooses. I look forward to sharing this "food for the soul" with all of you next week as we celebrate the beauty of Sacred Scripture together.

Vacation Time: You will notice that I am not on the schedule this upcoming week. I am on vacation. I just wanted to give you a heads up, because I know many of you are praying for my health, and when you don't see me, worry sets in. Fear not, I'm just on vacation, not sick. But keep the prayers coming; they are working! Thanks, and God bless.

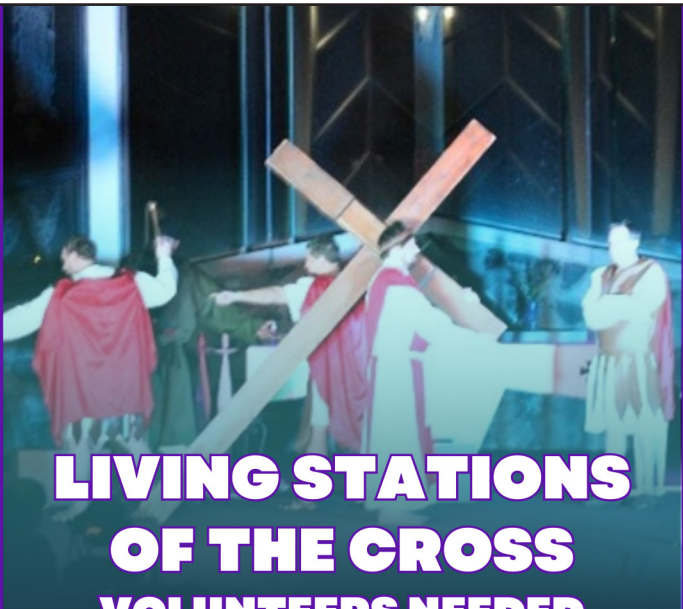
